Thank you for purchasing the **DeWay Battery-Operated Stick Transfer Pump with Auto-Stop Sensor**. This User Guide is intended to provide you with guidelines to ensure that operation of this product is safe and does not pose risk to the user. Any use that does not conform to the guidelines described in this User Guide may void the limited warranty.

Please read all directions before using the product and retain this guide for reference. This product is intended for household use only. It is not intended for commercial use. This product is covered by a limited one-year warranty. Coverage is subject to limits and exclusions. See warranty for details.

Safety Precautions

- Only use compatible liquids with this pump.
- Do not allow children to operate the product.
- Make sure to remove any liquid left in the hose after use.
- Do not use this pump for transferring the following liquids: acetone, benzene, cresol, ethyl, phenol, methyl ethyl, concentrated caustic soda liquid, nitric acid, hydrochloric acid, or sulfuric acid.
- Do not refuel directly while the vehicle or other equipment is turned on.
- Do not alter or disassemble the pump.
- Do not place the pump in a wet area.
- Do not turn the pump upside down after use.
- **CAUTION: Remove the batteries when not in use.**
- When using the pump on a fuel tank of a heater, turn the heater off and allow it to cool off first.
- Do not use corrosive chemicals in this pump.
- Do not leave pump unattended during operation.
- Make sure to turn off the pump before moving the device.
- Drain the pump of any remaining liquid after each use.
- Batteries are not included. When inserting batteries, make sure that the positive and negative polarities match with the markings in the compartment.
- Do not mix old and new batteries together.
- Do not use this pump on hot liquid above 104 °F (40 °C).
- Make sure connections are tight before using the pump to eliminate leaks.
- Do not operate when tired or when under the influence of drugs or medication.
- Do not use deteriorated or aged fuel.
- Do not use the pump on carpet, wood floors, or combustible areas.

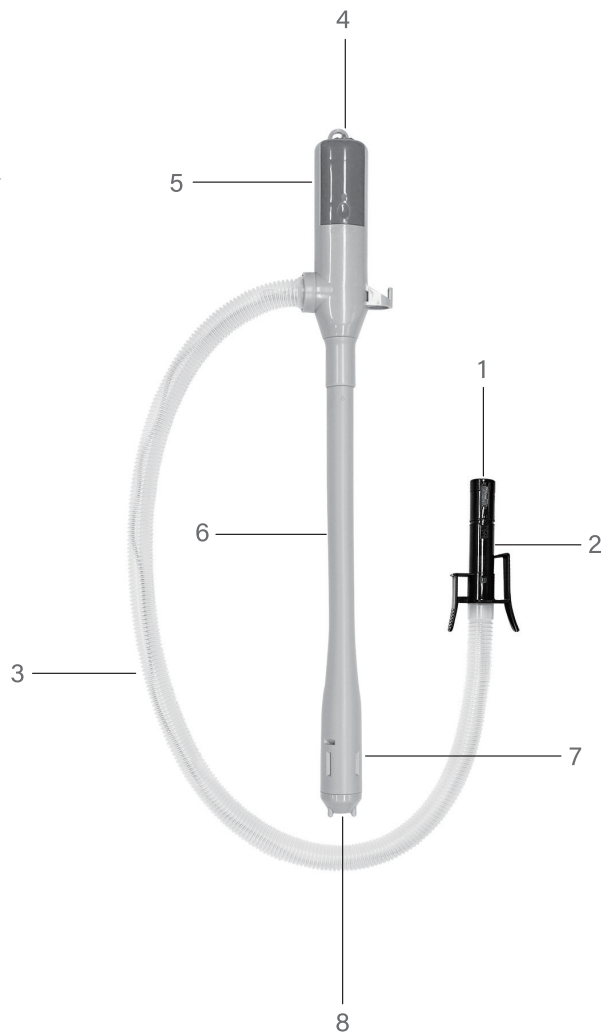

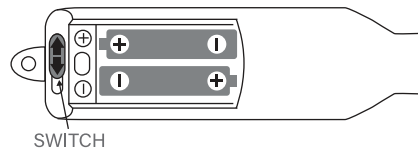
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Operating Instructions

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Installing the Batteries

- Remove the battery case cover by pushing upward on the grooves in the direction of the arrow.
- Insert two (2) AA batteries (not included) into the battery compartment.



- Slide the battery case cover back onto the battery compartment.

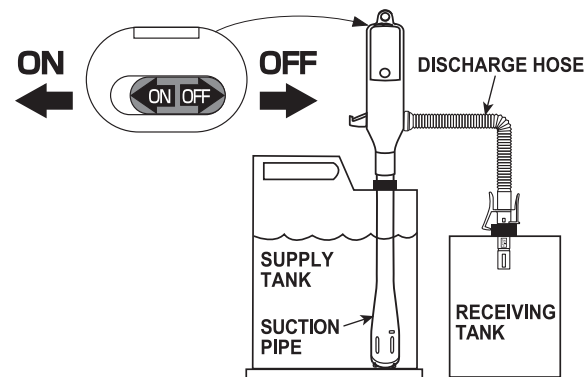
Operating the Pump

IMPORTANT: Most US gas cans come with a plastic strainer inside. The plastic strainer must be removed first so gas can properly flow out of the container. Use whatever tool you are comfortable with to remove the strainer. However, it is recommended to use a needle nose plier to easily grab the strainer and pull it out of the gas can opening. Once the plastic strainer is removed, then the intake hose can be inserted.

- Insert the suction tube into the supply tank making sure the bottom of the suction tube is submerged in the liquid being transferred.

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- Insert the spout of the nozzle into the receiving container. Use the clip to firmly attach the nozzle to the container and make sure the spout of the nozzle stays in a vertical position.



NOTE: Make sure the supply tank and receiving container are on the same level when the pump is operating.

- Start the pump flow by flipping the ON/OFF switch to the ON position.
NOTE: The pump flow will automatically stop when the liquid in the receiving container reaches the stop line on the nozzle. After the automatic stop, raise the discharge hose over the pump so excess fuel can drain back into the supply tank.

To stop the transfer flow manually:

- Flip the ON/OFF switch to the OFF position to manually stop the pump flow (if needed).

IMPORTANT: MAKE SURE THE END OF THE SUCTION TUBE IS COMPLETELY SUBMERGED UNDER THE LIQUID BEING USED BEFORE TURNING ON THE PUMP. FAILURE TO DO SO CAN CAUSE AIR TO GET TRAPPED IN THE SUCTION TUBE WHICH WILL DISRUPT THE OPERATION OF THE PUMP.

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Care & Storage

Storing the Pump

- When the pump is not in use for a long period of time, it should be properly stored. Before storing the pump:
- Make sure no fuel remains in the pump.
 - Wipe down the pump with a cloth.
 - Make sure to remove the batteries.
 - Find a clean, dry place appropriate for storage.

This DeWay Battery-Operated Stick Transfer Pump with Auto-Stop Sensor ("Product"), including any accessories included in the original packaging, as supplied and distributed new by an authorized retailer is warranted by C&A Marketing, Inc. The Company warrants the Product against defects in materials and workmanship under normal use for a period of ONE (1) YEAR from the date of retail purchase by the original end-user purchaser ("Warranty Period").
