FOOD SAFETY PLAN: CORRECTIVE ACTION / PREVENTIVE ACTIONS STATEMENT

As appropriate to the nature of the hazard and the nature of the preventive control, Edison Mercantile has established and implemented a written corrective action (CA) procedure to address the following:

- 2. Steps are taken to reduce the likelihood the problem will recur.
- 3. All affected food is evaluated for safety.
- 4. All affected food is prevented from entering the stream of commerce.

Corrections are taken in a timely manner, identifying and correcting conditions and practices that are not consistent with our established preventive controls (allergens/sanitation/processing/supply chain). All CA and when appropriate corrections are documented.

These records are subject to verification and review by QC/PCQI.
