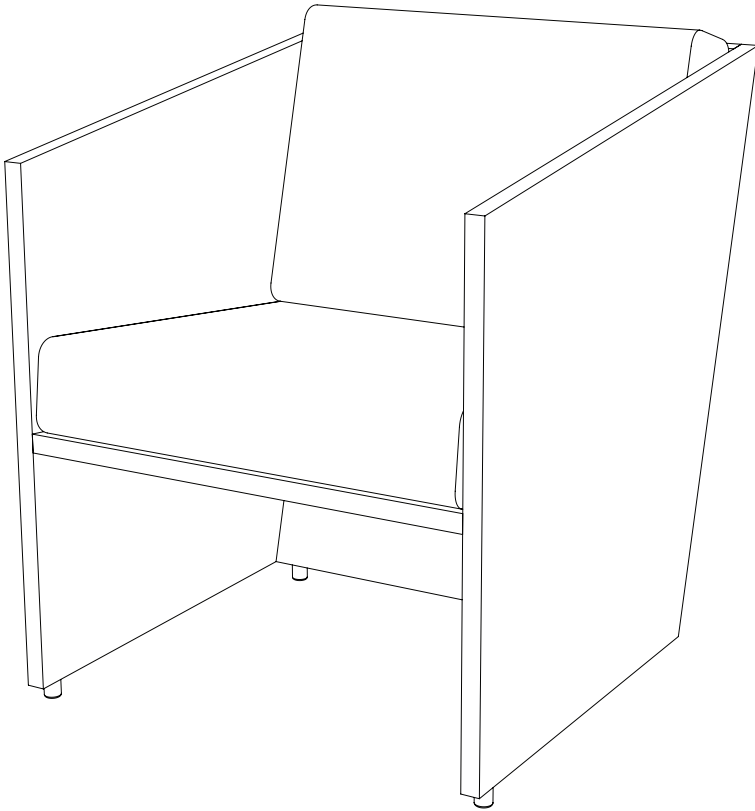

# ALCÂNTARA Chair



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## **ABOUT**

The initial idea was to come up with a simple chair that could fit any nice table, and was to be manufactured in solid wood. The CAST chair is a sturdy piece whose structure is ingeniously determined by the seat itself, giving it a classic and versatile look. The chair is available in various kinds of wood, as well upholstered in fabric or leather, with or without arms.

## **CARE AND MAINTENANCE**

The following care instructions are recommendations only.

### **Wood**

MOR seals its veneers with a high-quality finish. For this reason, to clean solid wood and veneered surfaces, we recommend using a soft, slightly damp cloth, with a mild detergent in the case of stubborn dirt. We recommend that you always use environmentally friendly cleaning products and care for your furniture regularly and frequently. Before using any cleaning product, you should test it on an inconspicuous spot. Please follow the cleaning product manufacturer's instructions and contact a professional cleaning company in case of stubborn dirt or stains.

To avoid stains and other damage, liquids should be wiped away immediately. Wet surfaces should be dried immediately with a cloth. To extend the life of our products we apply a natural varnish to highlight and protect the properties of the natural wood. However, wood furniture reacts to environment. Exposure to light can alter its colour and also adapt its own moisture content levels to that of its environment. In the case of excessive fluctuations in temperature and humidity, however, it reacts by cracking and warping.

### **Leather**

MOR leather elements are smooth high-quality crafted and should not be exposed to sunlight or heat sources. We recommend applying a mild cleaner once a year, to maintain the leather's natural water protective coat intact and its smoothness. For cleaning is recommended an appropriated leather cleaner in foam or liquid form, avoiding rubbing or pressure too hard and clean the entire surface, do not spot clean. Superficial dirt must be removed with a damp soft cloth, as to remove stains and in soiled spots should be applied a nonabrasive soap solution with a clean and a wet sponge. Clean well and let air dry. Do not apply direct water or wash grease spots. Do not use saddle soap, cleaning abrasive solvents, oils, furniture or shoe polishes, varnishes, detergents, or other aggressive substances. If stains remains or soiled areas persists, contact a professional cleaner. Remember that leather will age over time and create its own unique and lovely patina.

## **WARNING**

Do not use neat, harsh, strong or abrasive cleaning fluids or furniture polish containing silicone or abrasives. They most commonly contain unsuitable solvents and/or colour additives, which ultimately leave a coating that is very difficult to remove and may affect the colour and finish of the veneer surface. If possible, avoid rubbing the surface while cleaning it, as this will make matte finishes shiny and charge the varnish with static electricity which will attract more dust.
