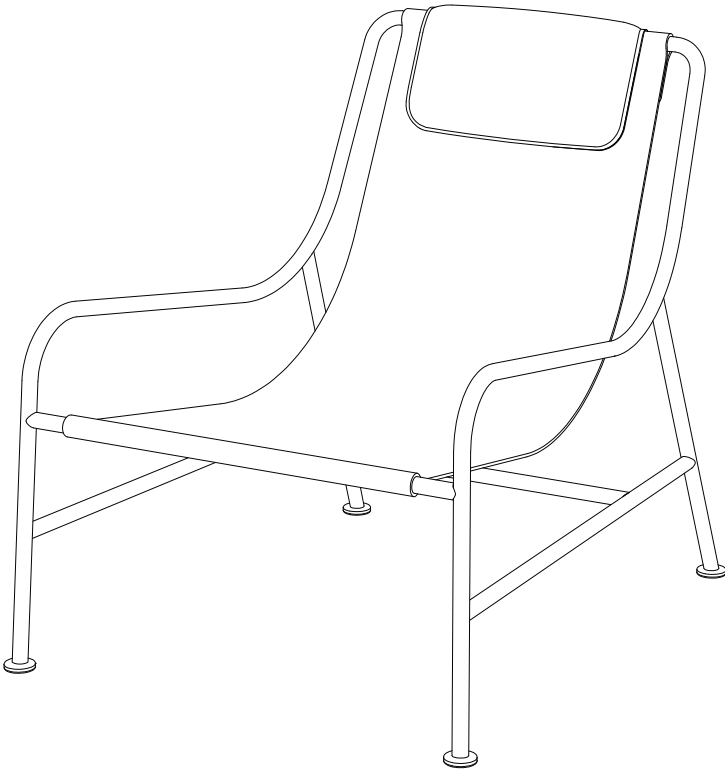

LISBOA Lounge Chair



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ABOUT

Embracing the purpose to take a break, LISBOA chair invites you to just sit and relax. Combining many observations from different cultures of how people use chairs and which role they play in their every-day life, Keiji Takeuchi designed the LISBOA lounge chair with a vision.

Made for moments of serenity, this chair is not only aesthetically pleasing but perfect to enjoy the easy life as much as possible. Due to the open structure of organically shaped stainless-steel tubes, the chair is very light, to be flexibly positioned wherever needed.

Sitting in a very low position, glasses or books can easily be placed on the ground, so side tables, despite of welcome, are not necessary. Practicality, material, proportions, and purpose create the atmospheric aesthetics of the chair, making it a functional yet sculptural piece of usage.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

The following care instructions are recommendations only.

Stainless steel

MOR metal surfaces are carefully made with high-quality finishes. To remove dirt, fingerprints, and contaminants on polished surfaces, apply a non-abrasive glass cleaner with a soft and clean cloth, then dry off the surface with another soft and dry cloth. For a better stainless-steel preservation, is recommended to apply a proper stainless-steel spray or detergent. Clean all metal surfaces gently and without scrubbing to not scratch or damage the surface. Do not use chlorine based cleaners, or substances with acetic or citric acid.

Leather

MOR leather elements are smooth high-quality crafted and should not be exposed to sunlight or heat sources. We recommend applying a mild cleaner once a year, to maintain the leather's natural water protective coat intact and its smoothness. For cleaning is recommended an appropriated leather cleaner in foam or liquid form, avoiding rubbing or pressure too hard and clean the entire surface, do not spot clean. Superficial dirt must be removed with a damp soft cloth, as to remove stains and in soiled spots should be applied a nonabrasive soap solution with a clean and a wet sponge. Clean well and let air dry. Do not apply direct water or wash grease spots. Do not use saddle soap, cleaning abrasive solvents, oils, furniture or shoe polishes, varnishes, detergents, or other aggressive substances. If stains remains or soiled areas persists, contact a professional cleaner. Remember that leather will age over time and create its own unique and lovely patina.

WARNING

Do not use neat, harsh, strong or abrasive cleaning fluids or furniture polish containing silicone or abrasives. They most commonly contain unsuitable solvents and/or colour additives, which ultimately leave a coating that is very difficult to remove and may affect the finish of the stainless-steel structure.
