

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS DO NOT DESTROY

READ INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY

Be sure to read carefully the accompanying instruction booklet before using this product.

- Do not use on infants, or people who have medical conditions or disabilities which leave them insensitive to heat.
- Do not tuck in the wired area of this product.
- Do not use if wet.
- Do not route electrical cords between the mattress and box spring.
- Do not allow the cords to be pinched.
- Keep the controller away from drafty areas that may become damp or wet such as an open window.
- Do not use pins they may damage the electric wiring.
- Be sure that this product is used on an alternating-current supply circuit at the proper voltage.
- Turn off or unplug when not in use.
- Excessive heating may result from folding when in use.
- If product becomes damaged, discontinue use immediately and consult the manufacturer or the dealer regarding repairs.
- Do not use with rocking chairs, recliners, chairs with casters or wheels, or other furniture subject to movement.

- Do not tuck the product or supply cord in a sofa or other furniture. All portions of the product or controller should be visible at all times.
- Wrapping the cord around the controller may damage the cord. Loop loosely when storing.
- Do not use dry-cleaning fluid on this bedding, cleaning solvents may have a deteriorating effect on the insulation of the heating element.
- Do not dry clean.

NOTE OF PLUG

This appliance has a polarized plug (one blade is wider than the other) as a safety feature.

This plug will fit into a polarized outlet only one way. If the plug does not fit fully into the outlet, reverse the plug.

If it still does not fit, contact a qualified electrician. Do not attempt to defeat this safety feature.

WASHING INSTRUCTIONS

Wash by hand or machine wash using Delicate Cycle:

- If using a top loading washing machine, first fill with warm water.
- Add minimum amount of all-purpose detergent, agitate to dissolve, measure bedding before washing.
- Add bedding and soak five minutes. Agitate two minutes. Spin. Fill for cool rinse, agitate one minute then spin.
- Dry in automatic dryer on low heat, five minutes only, or line dry.
- Gently reshape to original size and hang on clothesline to air dry.
- Do not iron.



CONTROLLER FEATURES



HEAT MODE

There are 10 Heat Setting Levels, with 1 being the lowest heat and 10 the highest heat. The temperature goes up from 1 to 10 each time the + or - buttons are pressed.


AUTO SHUT-OFF FEATURE

Controllers will automatically shut off 8 hours after being turned on. This is designed to provide added safety and conserve energy. To reactivate the heating feature simply press the ON/OFF button.

To restart after a power outage simply press the ON/OFF button.

CAUTION

- Make sure all cords are tangle-free and not pinched in any way, including but not limited to between mattress and box spring, against wall, chairs, or other furniture.
- Do not wrap the controller in the product while in use.
- Do not use with a power generator.



SET-UP PROCEDURE (continued)

STEP 1

Place blanket on the bed with controllers positioned near the head of the bed. Run the cord from the controller under bed and connect to the end of the blanket at the foot of the bed.

STEP 2



Locate cord connector on the product.

NOTE: PLUG CONTROLLER CORD TO PRODUCT FIRST! Do not plug controller into the wall outlet until you have connected the controller cord to the product.



To plug controller cord into the connector, align arrows on the connector and cord and push until they lock.

CAUTION: CORD MUST BE COMPLETELY CONNECTED. THERE IS A RISK FOR FIRE WITH A LOOSE CONNECTION.

STEP 4



Plug the power cord into a 120V wall outlet.

STEP 5



Turn on using ON/OFF button.

Controller will default to the lowest temperature setting.

STEP 6



Press the HEAT/TIMER Button to switch between Heat and Timer Modes.

In Heat Mode:

There are 10 Heating Settings with 1 being the lowest heat and 10 being the highest heat.

Temperature goes up as you move from 1 to 10 in Heat Mode using the + and - buttons.

In Timer Mode:

There is a timer mode from 1 to 12 hours. Use the + and - buttons to increase/decrease time.

If you set **1**, product will automatically shut off in one hour. Each number up to **12** indicates the number of hours product will be on until it automatically shuts off.

STEP 7



To disconnect the controller, first turn off using the ON/OFF button. Then, unplug the cord from the outlet, pinch sides of the connector and pull apart.

CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

Please follow the cleaning procedures as below.

Note: before cleaning electric heated products, please disconnect the controller from the product. **DO NOT get the controller wet and do not wash with the controller attached.**

SPOT CLEANING

- Clean the stained area with a sponge or soft cloth dipped in gentle detergent.
- Repeat using clean water and then dry with an absorbent towel.

HAND WASH

- Add mild detergent to clean water and soak the product.
- After 5 minutes of soaking, take out and lightly squeeze out excess liquid. Do not twist or wring.
- Rinse with lukewarm water. Lightly squeeze out excess liquid. Do not twist or wring.

MACHINE WASH

- This product can be washed in a non-commercial washing machine only.
- Use Delicate Cycle with all-purpose laundry detergent.
- Water temperature should be kept under 86°F/30°C.
- Do not rinse on high speed.
- Do not wash the controller.

LINE DRYING

- Reshape and hang the product on clothes line evenly to dry naturally.
- Do not use clothes pins.



- Do not dry clean or iron.
- Warning: do not twist or wring.
- Warning: disconnect and remove the controller from the product before washing.
- Warning: do not soak the controller in any liquid.
- Warning: do not use the product when it is not fully dried.

STORAGE

- Disconnect the controller from product prior to storage.
- Allow this product to cool before folding and storing it, as you would any other bedding.
- When not in use, please place the product back into the original package and store in a cool, dry place.
- Avoid storing near sharp objects and avoid placing heavy objects on top.

TROUBLESHOOTING



Please attach the cord to this product **before** plugging the cord into the electrical outlet.

My product doesn't work? What could be possible causes?

- **Controller is not properly connected or is loose:** Check whether the controller is properly connected.
- Wall plug is loose: Check if the plug is properly plugged in all the way.
- Product shut off by timer: Turn on using ON/OFF Button.
- **Product is damaged:** Unplug and contact Customer Service.

My heated product isn't warming up enough / inadequate heating. What can I do?

Perhaps the heating mode/temperature is not high enough, adjust setting to a higher level.

My remote is not working. How can I get a replacement?

If your remote is not working, you can follow our Quality Claims Procedure. We will request photographic proof of the issue you are experiencing, and we will either have you send it back at no charge so we can inspect the item or ask you to dispose of it. We will then have a replacement remote shipped to you free of charge.

I want a longer cord for my heated product. Can I purchase a longer one?

We do not currently carry remotes with cord lengths that vary.

What does a blinking "F" on my remote's LCD screen mean?

Try unplugging, disconnect from the heated product, then reconnect and plug the remote back in to the wall. If this doesn't work, please register for our replacement warranty, follow our Quality Claims Procedure, and we will either send you a new remote or provide a coupon code for you to purchase a new heated product on our website free of charge.
