Dear JourneyWoman,

It's hard to believe it's already February... the year is whizzing by already! Like you, I'm counting the days until we can all travel safely again!

Thank you to those who responded to my #TravelReady survey. I'd like to share some of the results from it with you. 33% said you are waiting until 2022 to travel internationally, 30% are planning to travel in the second half of this year and 29% are 'not sure'. While many said they will travel solo (47%), 50% will travel with a partner or friend and 27% will travel with a group tour. When you do travel again, the first trip will be to Europe (37%), followed by the UK and Ireland (13%) and 65% will stay in a small boutique hotel while 37% will use a homestay.

In your feedback, you also asked us to focus more on travel insurance (40%). We know this is an important topic and recently held our <u>first "Travel Essentials" session on January 7</u>; I'm planning more on this soon. You also asked for more information on government/hotel/airline travel requirements (66%). An interesting area to watch here will be vaccine passports, which could eliminate the need for quarantine on arrival and accelerate the return of international tourism. The challenge, as this <u>New York Times</u> article articulates, is creating a document or app that is accepted around the world, protects privacy and is accessible to people regardless of their wealth or access to smartphones.

In this time, we are all learning together. The JourneyWoman community has more travel experience than any other group of women in the world. As we wait to travel, I invite you to share your wisdom and lessons learned with other women. I'm eager to facilitate that through the editorial on our website and virtual events such as our new Solo Travel Wisdom talk show. I
