88% of Boomer and GenX Women Have Felt Threatened or Unsafe while Travelling

In April, to support a series of classes on women's self-defense skills, we invited women to share their experiences on personal safety in a global survey. Completed by over 350 women, almost 90% of respondents were age 55 and over.

Methodology

We regularly conduct surveys with our global audience of adventurous female travellers to guide our editorial, events and design new services and partnerships.

Respondents

Approximately 54% live in the US. Over 35% live in Canada, with the remaining 10% in 100+ other countries including India, Australia, the UK, and New Zealand.






Safety is not destination-specific; it is a mindset
