Dear Goddess,

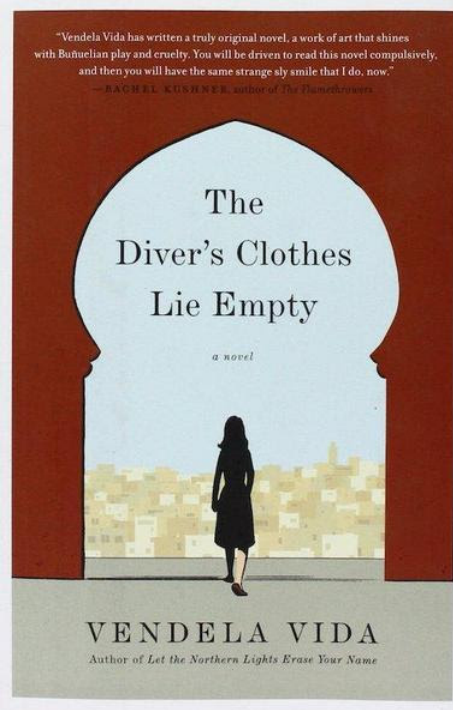

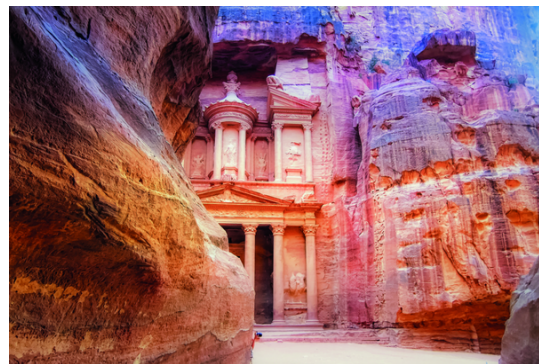
