






# **How to Assemble your new Comfort Commode**

1. Lay the Seat on a covered flat surface like a table or counter with the seat top facing down. Line the back edge up with the edge of your surface.




**5.** Turn chair upright and place it on a flat surface or the ground.




2. The Right Leg attaches to the tubes on the underside of the Seat. The Legs height adjustment holes face the back of the seat. Press the spring pins on the Seats tubes and slide the Leg on.


The pins will click in place.



6. To attach Armrests, press the spring pin down on the rear support, then slide the Armrest on. The Armrest should be angled downward, so the spring pin locks into the armrest with an audible click.




3. Repeat step 2 with the left leg. The spring pins should click securely into the holes on the legs.




7. Pull the armrest up from the front until it locks into place.


The spring-loaded locking pin will secure itself in the bracket on the side of the commode with an audible click.



4. Double check to ensure the legs are on the correct side. The height adjustment holes face the back of the chair. The Armrests will not attach properly if the legs are on the wrong side.



8. Lift the lid and seat. If you will be placing the commode over a toilet, insert the splash guard. If you will be using the commode away from a toilet, insert the pail.




# **Optional Backrest Attachment**


Your commode can be used over a toilet with the splash guard installed. Consider leaving the Backrest off when using the commode over a toilet.

1. For use away from the toilet, replace the splash guard with the pail and attach the Backrest for a furniture look and feel. Slide lip of Backrest between rear support and seat.

The Backrest lip will be underneath the seat.




2. Securely clip the Backrest to the rear support bar.



3. Tilt the commode forward and attach the bottom lip of the Backrest to the underside of the Seat using included thumb screws.




Do not over-tighten.




## **How to Adjust the Height**

 Press the spring pin on one leg and pull the lower portion of the leg to the desired height.



3. Before using your new commode, confirm all spring pins are securely locked in place. The sound of the click will be audible.













# **Use and Tips**


- Arm rests can be lowered to provide more space or facilitate side transfers. Pull locking pin knob to release and lower each arm.
- To return, pull Armrests up to engage locking pins into brackets on each side of the commode.





## **Important**

- 1. Do not exceed weight capacity of 350 lbs.
- To ensure an even and stable height, make sure that the height-adjustment buttons are securely through and visibly protruding through the same respective height adjustment hole on each leg.
- 3. Check height adjustment points and all joints and fittings before each use to ensure product is secure and stable.
- 4. If commode is being used over the toilet, the toilet seat must be down to ensure a stable fit over the toilet. The toilet lid must be lifted or removed before using the commode.
- 5. Ensure the arms are fully locked and secured into the side of the chair before putting any weight on them.
- 6. When unlocking and stowing the arms, carefully slide each arm back to avoid any swing that could harm the user or surroundings.
- 7. Do not use if the rubber leg tips look cracked or worn.
- 8. Wipe clean with a nonabrasive cleaner and warm water.
- 9. Do not stand on commode.
