



Parts for your new Easy Fold Travel Walker



The Active Angle

Most walker grips are parallel to the ground. These walker grips angle down towards the front to help improve your posture and wrist comfort.




Premium Quality Feet

Ditch the yellow tennis balls because these are contoured to glide across surfaces. When you lean on the walker a rubber foot emerges and securely grips the ground.



Front Wheels or Four Premium Quality Feet?



First, determine whether you need Wheels or Feet on the front of your walker.

If you are unsure, check with your healthcare provider.


This walker is not designed for use with wheels on all four legs.

How to Attach the Premium Quality Feet

1. Align one of the Feet to the Wishbone Base, and insert it into the Base.


The two spring pins on the Premium Quality Foot will click into place on the leg when properly attached.

2. Repeat for the other Premium Quality Foot.




How to Attach the Wheels

1. The Wheels are Left/Right side specific. Each Wheel should be attached so that they are on the outside of the Wishbone Base, with the fender tab facing the same direction as the height adjustment holes on the Wishbone Base.



- 2. Insert the Left Wheel into the Wishbone Base. **The spring pin on the Wheel will click into place** on the Wishbone Base when properly attached.
- 3. Repeat for the Right Wheel. The spring pin on the Wheel will click into place.




4. Engage the brakes for the rest of the assembly process by pressing the fender tab down. The Wheels should not be able to roll. If they still roll, do not use and contact customer service.




1. Open the Cam-Lock Lever on the Cam-Lock at the top of the Wishbone Base.




4. Repeat step 3 with the other Lower Rear Leg. Ensure spring pin pops into one of the height adjustment holes on the Lower Rear Leg with an **audible "click."**




2. Press the spring-pin on the front tube of the Handlebar and insert it into the Wishbone Base until the spring pin pops into one of the height adjustment holes on the Base with an **audible "click"** (all height adjustment holes face the back of the walker).



3. Press the spring pin on the back leg of the Handlebar and insert it into a Lower Rear Leg until the spring pin pops into one of the height adjustment holes on the Lower Rear Leg with an **audible "click"** (All height adjustment holes face the back of the walker).




5. Make sure all spring pins are locked securely in place.




6. Close the Cam-Lock Lever on the front column.

If the Cam-Lock Lever does not feel tight or is able to move, do not use. You must turn the adjustment knob opposite the lever to adjust it so the lever closes tightly.


How to Adjust the Height of your new Walker



1. Typically, the walker height should be set so the grips align with the inner crease of your wrist when you are standing up straight and looking forward. Confirm what is right for you with your healthcare provider.


This is the same whether you use 4 feet, or 2 wheels and 2 feet.

3. Open the Cam-Lock Lever on the Front Column.




4. Press the spring pin on the Front Column and adjust the height to the **same hole** as the Lower Rear Legs.

Never set the Front Column to a different height from the Rear Legs.




2. Press the spring pin on a Lower Rear Leg and set the height to the appropriate hole as indicated in step 1 above. Repeat for the other Lower Rear Leg, **ensuring the legs are set at the same height.**




5. Close the Cam-Lock Lever on the front column.

If the Cam-Lock Lever does not feel tight or is able to move, do not use. You must turn the knob opposite the Cam-Lock Lever to adjust it so the Lever closes tightly.




To fold, pull each trigger upward and rotate each grip inward until trigger drops back down into place. It does not matter which side you fold inward first.




To lock each wheel, step down on the fender tab to set the brake. If they still roll, do not use and contact customer service.

Make sure the brakes are locked when leaning folded walker against a wall or other object.




Use and Tips

To unfold, pull each trigger upward and rotate each grip outward until trigger drops down into place.




To unlock each wheel, push up on the fender tab to release the brake.



Inspect wheels and feet regularly for wear/ damage. To remove wheels or feet, press the spring pins above the wheel or foot, then pull the wheel or foot to remove.

Replacement walker wheels are available on **CVS.com**, item 243577.



Important

- 1. Do not exceed weight capacity of 300 lbs.
- 2. To ensure an even and stable height, make sure that the height-adjustment buttons are securely through and visibly protruding through the same respective height adjustment hole on each leg.
- 3. Check height adjustment points and all joints and fittings before each use to ensure product is secure and stable.
- 4. Before each use, ensure that the frame is fully unfolded and stable, and wheels and feet are securely affixed to the walker. Cam-lock lever should be in a secure, closed position.
- 5. Do not leave your Walker in moist places; dry it immediately if it exposed to moisture.
- 6. All feet and wheels must be in contact with the ground during use to prevent injury or fall.
- 7. Do not use for support on stairs or ramps.
- 8. Do not use to move backwards.
- 9. Do not use the frame of the walker to hang or store any personal belongings.
- **10.** Do not use the walker as an aid stand up as wheels could still roll and loss of balance or injury could occur.
- **11.** When engaging the brake on or off, ensure that your other foot is firmly grounded and you are well balanced before using your foot or bending down.
- Check walker wheels and feet periodically for wear and replace as needed. Replacement wheels are available on CVS.com, part number 243577.
