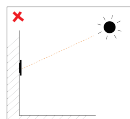
## Installation Environment

Please do not place device under direct sunlight.

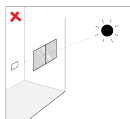
If installing the device indoors, please keep device at least 2 meters away from light, and at least 3 meters away from window and door .



Backlight



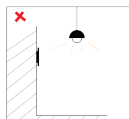
Direct sunlight

Indirect sunlight through window



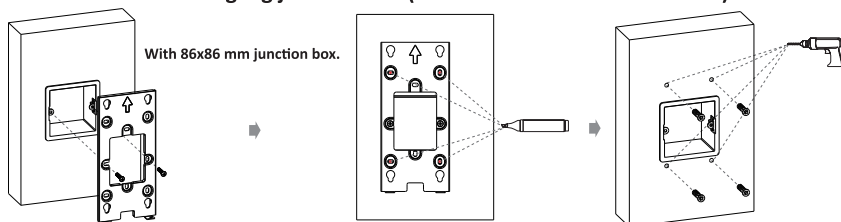
Close to light

## Installation

### On-Wall Mounting

#### Step 1: Wall-mounting Bracket/Box Installation

1. With embedded one-gang junction box (86x86 mm or 2x3 inches in size) in the wall.



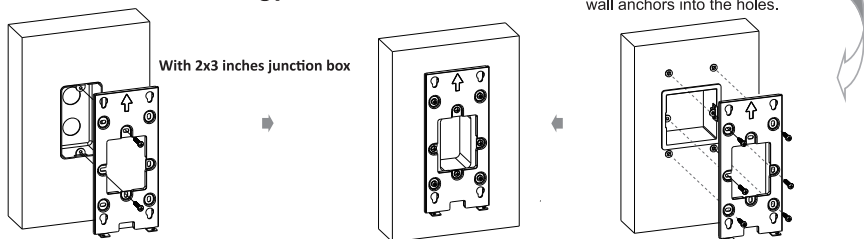
With 86x86 mm junction box.

Fix the wall-mounting bracket on the 86x86mm embedded box with two M4x30 crosshead screws.

Mark the four holes of the wall-mounting bracket on the wall.

Use a hand drill with 6mm diameter bit to drill four screw holes with a depth of 25mm at the marked positions. Then insert four plastic wall anchors into the holes.

or



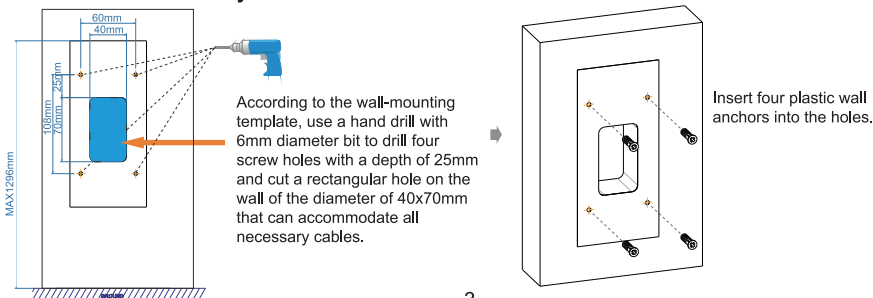
With 2x3 inches junction box

Fix the wall-mounting bracket to the 2x3 inches junction box with two M4x30 crosshead screws.

Finish the wall-mounting bracket installation.

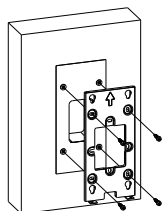
Fix the wall-mounting bracket with four ST4x20 crosshead screws and two M4x30 crosshead screws.

2. Without embedded junction box in the wall

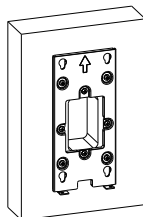


According to the wall-mounting template, use a hand drill with 6mm diameter bit to drill four screw holes with a depth of 25mm and cut a rectangular hole on the wall of the diameter of 40x70mm that can accommodate all necessary cables.

Insert four plastic wall anchors into the holes.

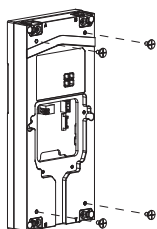


Fix the wall-mounting bracket with four ST4x20 crosshead screws.

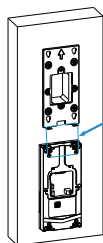


Finish the wall-mounting bracket installation.

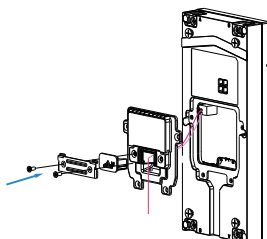
## Step2: Wiring Cover Installation



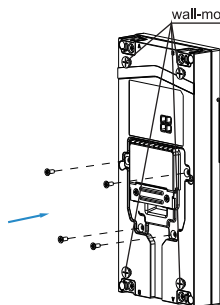
Install four wall-mounting screws to the back of the device.



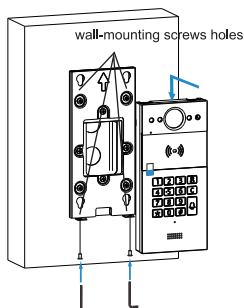
For convenient wiring, hang R20K-2 on the wall-mounting bracket with rope.



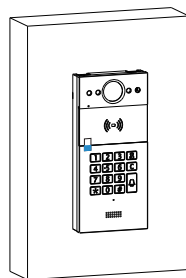
Make cables go through the wiring cover, connecting to the corresponding interfaces of the main board. Select a suitable size rubber plug to push all the cables into the wiring cover. Fix sealing pressing plate to the wiring cover with two M2.5x6 crosshead screws.



Fasten the wiring cover with four M2.5x6 crosshead screws.



Insert the four wall-mounting screws on the device into the corresponding holes on the wall-mounting bracket, and then press down to slide the wall-mounting screws into the groove. Then use the allen wrench to tighten the device with two M3x6 hex socket screws.

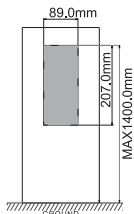

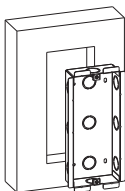
## Flush-mounting

### Step 1: Flush-mounting Bracket/Box Installation

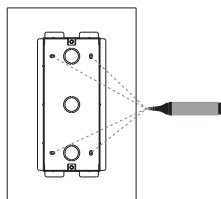
#### 1. Normal installation



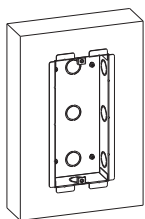
Cut a rectangular hole on the wall (height\*width\*depth=207\*89\*40mm) that can accommodate all the cables.



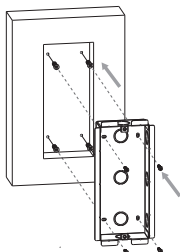
Insert the flush-mounting box into the hole.



Mark the four holes of the flush-mounting box on the wall.

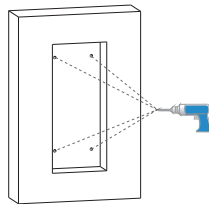


Flush the flush-mounting box installation.



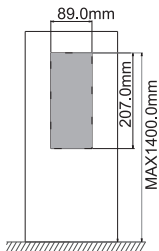
Insert four plastic wall anchors into the holes you drilled before.

Fix the flush-mounting box with four ST4x20 crosshead screws.

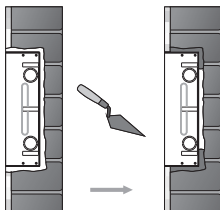


Take down the embedded box, then drill (6mm drill bit required) the four marked fixing holes on the wall with a depth of 25mm.

#### 2. Or you can choose another simple method without fixing ST4x20 screws



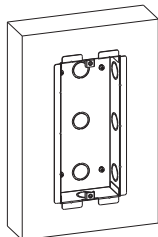
Cut a rectangular hole on the wall (height\*width\*depth=207\*89\*40mm) that can accommodate all the cables.



Use cement or non-corrosive structural adhesives to fill the gap between the wall and flush-mounting box. Wait the adhesive material desiccation, go to the next step.

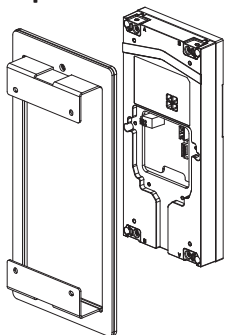
##### Waterproof Tips:

- For flush-mounting installation, it is recommended to fill the gaps around the embedded box for waterproofing (to prevent water from entering the gap in the wiring cover of the door phone).
- For wall-mounting installation, it is recommended to lock the wall-mounting bracket and the wall so that the EVA pasted on the bottom of the wall-mounting bracket is close to the wall without a gap (to prevent water from entering the gap in the wiring cover of the door phone).
- Or it is recommended to use a rain cover.

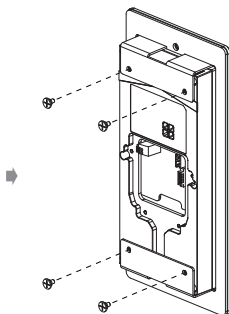


Finish the flush-mounting box installation.

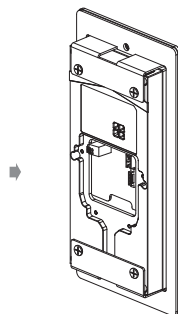
## Step2: Flush-mounting Bracket Installation



Combine the device with the flush-mounting bracket according to the direction indicated in the drawing.

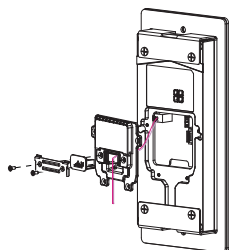
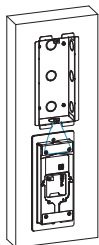


Tighten the device onto the flush-mounting bracket with four wall-mounting screws.



Flush-mounting bracket installation is completed.

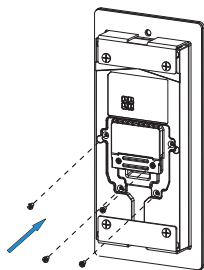
## Step3: Wiring Cover Installation



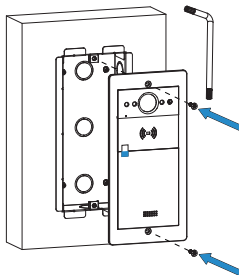
Make cables go through the wiring cover, connecting to the corresponding interfaces of the main board. Select a suitable size rubber plug to push all the cables into the wiring cover. Fix sealing pressing plate to the wiring cover with two M2.5x6 crosshead screws.

Note: In the case of one network cable or less than 6 signal cables, use S-size rubber plugs. In the case of 7 to 10 signal cables, use M-size rubber plugs. When there are more than 11 signal cables, please use L-size wiring rubber plug.

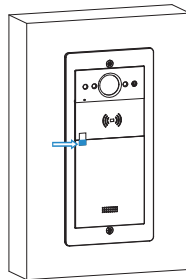
For convenient wiring, hang R20K-2 on the flush-mounting box with rope.



Fasten the wiring cover with four M2.5x6 crosshead screws.

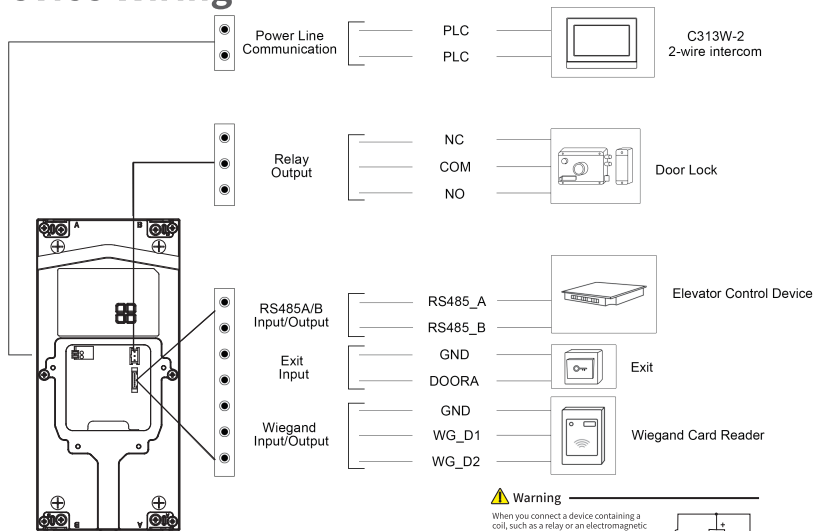


Install the device on the flush-mounting bracket using two M4x15 torx head screws.



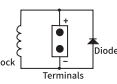
Installation completed, please remove the protective film.

## Device Wiring



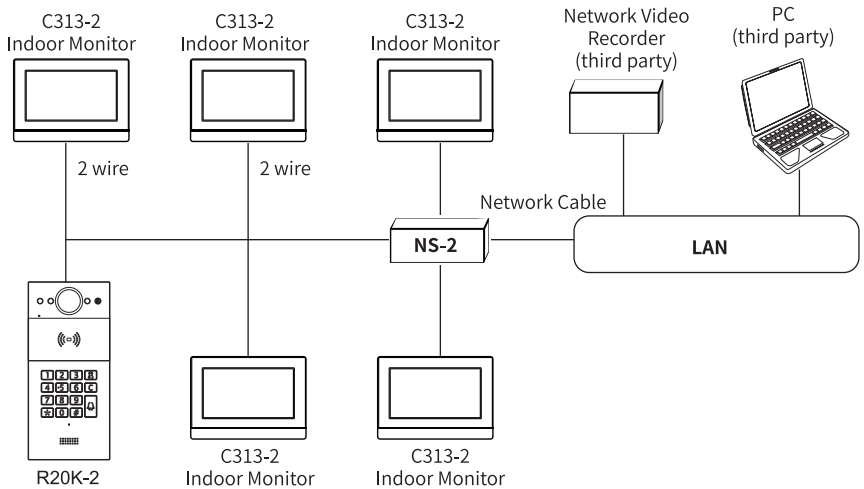
### Warning

When you connect a device containing a coil, such as a relay or an electromagnetic lock, it is necessary to protect the intercom against voltage peak while switching off the induction load. For this way of protection we recommend a diode 1 A / 200 V (included in the accessories) connected antiparallel to the device.



## Application Network Topology

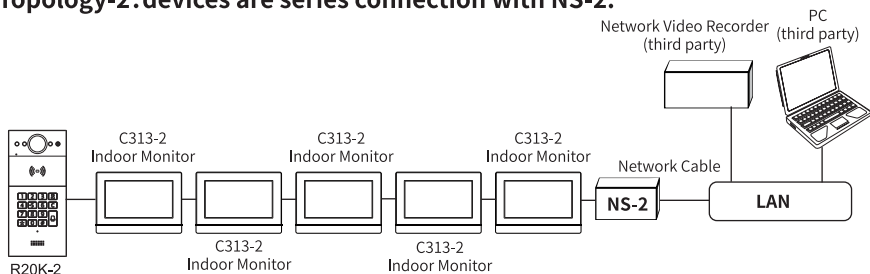
**Topology-1: each device connect to NS-2 separately.**

Note: When using different cable, the maximum number of devices can connect to NS-2 under the different maximum distances which can refer to the above table. For example, when using a 24awg cable, if the farthest distance is 100m, the maximum number of devices connect to NS-2 is 6.

## IP Announcement

1. While R20K-2 starts up normally, press \*3258\*, voice system will enter IP announcement mode.
2. In announcement mode, the IP address will be announced periodically.
3. Press Cancel Button again to quit the announcement mode.
4. In announcement mode, phone announces "IP 0.0.0.0" if no IP address is gained.

## Configuration

1. Access the Web UI: Input the IP address into web browser to configure the phone.
2. Account Registration: On web UI, go to the path: **Account > Basic** page Register Account and fill in the account information. ( Please refer to user manual for more information)
3. Configure the Manager button: On web UI, go to the path: **Intercom > Basic > Manager Dial** to configure the call number.
4. Configure the code to open the relay: On web UI, go to the path: **Intercom > Relay > Relay ID/DTMF** and choose the DTMF code number in corresponding area.

## Operation

### Make a call:

Press the manager button to call indoor SIP Phone.

### Receive a call:







R20K-2 supports Auto Answer by default. Incoming call from indoor device will be answered automatically.

### Unlock:

1. During the talk, called party can press pre-configured code number to unlock the door.
2. Scan the predefined RFID card nearby the card reader to unlock.
3. Press the predefined pin code to unlock.
