WARRANTY

Frame – 1825 interiors' Australian-made, custom-made sofa structure has a 15 year warranty. The solid timber frame is glued, screwed and reinforced, providing strength and longevity.

Webbing – The support system comprises Black Cat industrial webbing which carries a 10 year warranty. Black Cat industrial webbing is extremely resilient and offers excellent cushion support. 1825 interiors uses an additional E350 webbing to add extra support and increased durability.

SEATING COMFORT

- We use quality Dunlop Foams
- All foams have a 10 year guarantee
- All foams have been Ultra Fresh treated against mould, mildew, fungi and dust mites

- All foams are made in Australia without ozone-depleting CFCs
- Select custom-made sofas and armchairs can be made with your choice of seating comfort: firm, medium and soft
- All foam seating is wrapped in a layer of Dacron for added comfort
- Initially, your new sofa seats may feel firmer than the ones you tried in-store but will soften with wear over time, while still maintaining their shape and bounce
- Different fabric weaves can also add or subtract from the firmness of a foam: 5% tolerance is considered normal
- Generally, a heavyweight fabric will make the seat cushion feel firmer whereas a lightweight fabric will give the seat cushion a softer feel

FABRIC CHOICE

FABRIC CARE

As each fabric is composed of different fibres, it is important to refer to the label sewn into your seat base, or the supplier's website, for specific care and maintenance instructions.

Colour care

It is important to note that no fabric is 100% colour fast and that it is impossible to prevent colours fading unless adequate precautions are taken in the home. Place fabric sofas away from direct sunlight and heat. Fumes from chimneys, gas and open fires, auto exhausts and stoves all contribute to discolouration and deterioration of fabric.

General care

Vacuum weekly using low suction and treat stains and spills as soon as they occur. 1825 interiors offers fabric protection at an additional cost to help repel stains.

Fabric protection

We highly recommend purchasing fabric protection by Guardsman for peace of mind. It comes with a 5 year warranty against accidental stains and damage.

Spot cleaning

Stains and spills must be treated as soon as possible. Test in an inconspicuous area first to ensure fabric and colour are not removed. Gently scrape any solids or mop any liquids from the surface of the fabric. Use of soap or detergent with water should be approached with caution as overzealous rinsing to remove soap residue may result in over-wetting, watermarks, and wetting of the substructure. This may create additional stains or damage the product. We recommend Halo Fabric Spot Cleaner, available from 1825 interiors stores.

Our spot cleaning advice is offered in good faith and should not be considered a guarantee that all stains can be removed. For severe stains please consult a professional upholstery cleaner.

Professional cleaning

The frequency of professional cleaning is determined by furniture use, upkeep and environmental conditions. As a good rule of thumb, professional cleaning is recommended every 12 months for most fabric sofas.

Pilling

Pilling can occur occasionally as a result of normal daily wear and tear, climatic conditions, user environment and some clothing types, and should not be considered a fault. Pills can be removed with a battery-operated pilling tool available from most haberdashery stores. De-pilling only removes unsightly loose surface fibres and will not affect fabric performance.

Yellowing

In any room where tobacco is smoked, fumes will result in most fabrics being stained a yellow/brown colour, particularly lighter fabrics.

WASHABLE SLIP COVERS

Every Warwick Slip-Wash-Cover fabric is tested for seam slippage, abrasion resistance, colour fastness to light and cleaning. They have been commercially pre-washed and tested to ensure they can be washed and tumble dried on a regular basis without fear of shrinkage. All fabrics conform to the relevant industry standards.

Please follow these instructions carefully when replacing your loose covers after cleaning.

Ensure that the zip (if fitted) is fully open, then locate cover over both top back corners.



Repeat the previous operation on the second arm.



2 Draw cover forward over first arm and make sure that the facing fits over the front arm panel.



Tuck in excess cover between seat and sides and back. Straighten skirt at base and zip up.

Washing Instructions: Use a warm, gentle wash cycle but do not exceed 40 degrees. Do not use laundry detergents containing optical brighteners, or apply detergent directly to covers. Do not dry in direct sunlight. May be tumble dried cool. Ironing should not be necessary but, if required, iron on the reverse side using a light steam.
