

Cleaning your My Greens System

Periodically, your My Greens system will need a good clean. Salts, algae, leaves, roots and other "stuff" needs to be removed before they becomes an issue. Parts that will need cleaning are the water/ nutrient container, white PVC grow channels, pipes and the pump.

Cleaning of your My Greens system is best done in cool conditions as some plants will need to be removed while cleaning.



STEP 1: Disconnect power.

STEP 2: Remove plants from one of the top channels and lay down on a soft damp surface.

STEP 3: Remove top channel and hose out with water, removing as much "stuff" as possible, repeat with all channels, replacing plants as you go.

STEP 4: Remove pump from Water/ Nutrient container and wash pump with hose, brushing lightly as required.

STEP 5: Drain Water/ Nutrient container by opening tap (liquid can safely be put around garden plants), wash out with hose and scrub where required.

STEP 6: Fill up Nutrient/ Water container, add pH lower and Nutrients to required readings. Turn on the pump.

Cups: These can be re-used multiple times. Once used, simply clean with warm water (add detergent if you like).
