This product contains ethylene glycol monobutyl ether (EGBE) which has been shown to cause red blood cell hemolysis with secondary injury to the kidney and liver in laboratory animals. Humans are expected to be considerably less sensitive to this effect than animals. Inhalation of a maternally toxic concentration of EGBE in the rat and rabbit throughout gestation was associated with embryotoxicity. Humans are also expected to be less sensitive to this effect.
