Tannin is a decayed organic material and is present in many water supplies but goes unnoticed due to its low levels.

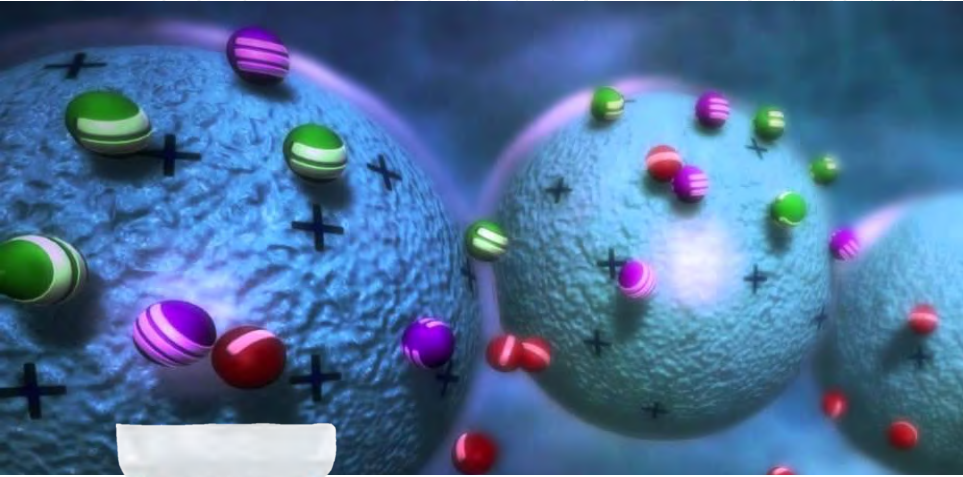
While tannins are not harmful to your health, they are not aesthetically pleasing and can range from light yellow to dark tea.

As a matter of fact, tannin gives your tea and coffee its dark color!

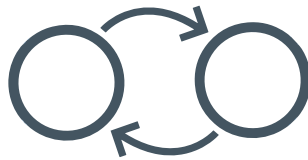
Nitrate
