THE PROCESS OF OUR LIGHTING DESIGN

LIGHTING DESIGN PLAN

A CAD plan that combines aesthetics, lighting level calculations, and several lighting techniques. Our designs are artistically based keeping national and local electrical codes, along with wattage and load restraints where applicable, in mind.

CONSTRUCTION ADMIN

Coordination with the construction team to assist, revising plans and specifications as needed. Two site visits are included for the critical stages of the lighting implementation of pre-Rough-in and pre-Sheet rock.

COMMISSIONING

Once the construction project is completed and the project is furnished and decorated, a site visit is made to adjust and aim the lighting as intended. Lighting scenes are set at this stage, if a lighting control system was installed.



ENHANCING ARCHITECTURE

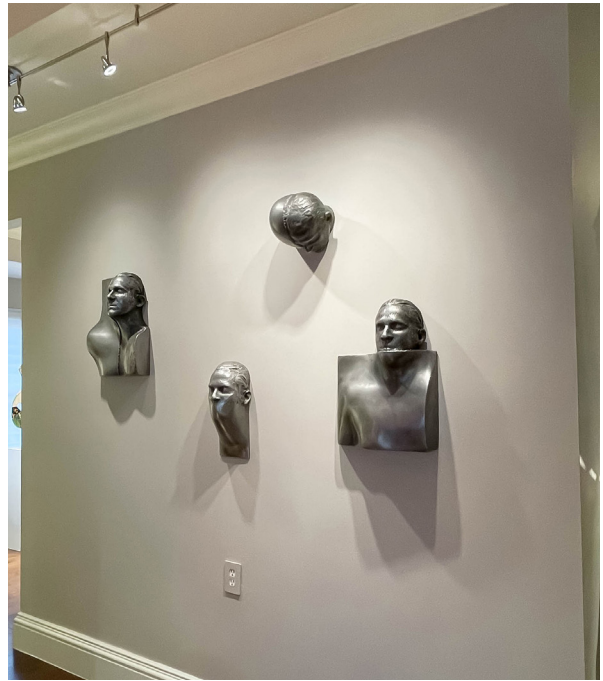
Architectural details, such as textured walls, coffered ceilings, accent coves, and archways are highlighted.

CONTROL + THE ABSENCE OF LIGHT

Lighting & Bulbs Unlimited offers lighting control systems. With a Certified Lighting Consultant, Lutron Pro, and multiple certified Lighting Associates on staff, we aim to create a lighting plan that allows each client to be as hands-free as possible.

Lighting and control systems are the backbone of integration and automation. They integrate with other devices, such as the thermostat, shades, and of course the lighting itself. Each client still has the ability to make changes all on their own without being locked into any subscription service that requires outside help (but of course, we're always here to help when anything is needed).

Motorized shades that can be controlled with this lighting control system are also part of our product offering, and therefore can be drawn into any home or office space design. The control aspect, allows for us to join the pairing of your lighting layout with the shades throughout the entire home.

Take a "Movie Time scene" for example. At the touch of a button on the wall, or on your app, the lighting in the entire home will adjust to predetermined levels. Imagine relaxing on your sofa. As you lift your feet onto the ottoman, you tap "Movie Time" on your phone. The living room slowly fades down to a dim; the shades over the windows quietly come to a blackout close. The guest bath and its hallway slowly turn on to its lowest level of light. The kitchen recessed lighting and pendants fade off, while the under-cabinet lighting dims on to a low level, allowing for a safe, mid-movie snack run that doesn't disturb the rest of the family engaging in the film.

Each lifestyle is unique. We aim to embrace the beauty of your lifestyle to have your lighting work around your life, not the other way around.
