SOLAR LANTERN (with 3 screws) BATTERY REPLACEMENT INSTRUCTIONS

- If your Solar Lantern stops lighting up even with 6-8 hours of direct sunlight, you may need to replace the battery as follows:
- a. Remove frame support wire and collapse the lantern flat to allow access to the bottom of the solar housing
- b. Slide the ON/OFF switch to OFF (see figure 1)
- c. Using a small Phillips head screwdriver, unscrew the three screws (see figure 1) and remove the cover to expose the inside of the solar housing (see figure 2)
- d. Remove existing AAA battery and replace with the new <u>rechargeable</u> AAA battery.
- e. Replace cover by aligning ON/OFF switch to hole, fasten screws, slide ON/OFF switch to ON, and reassemble lantern.
