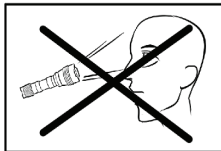

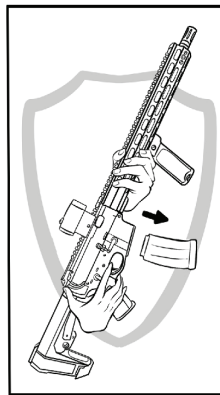

IMPORTANT WARNINGS

CAUTION: The Star★Trio Long Gun Combo Light features a powerful beam that may cause the device to become uncomfortably warm when operated for an extended duration. The increased temperature does not present a burn hazard, and the device is safe to use in tactical situations, such as clearing rooms or checking for intruders, for short periods of time.

FAILURE TO READ AND FOLLOW THESE OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS AND WARNINGS WHEN HANDLING A FIREARM OR THE STAR★TRIO LONG GUN COMBO LIGHT CAN BE DANGEROUS AND CAN RESULT IN SERIOUS INJURY, DAMAGE TO PROPERTY, OR DEATH.

- Use of a firearm under any circumstance may be dangerous. SERIOUS INJURY OR EVEN DEATH may result without proper training in the safe handling of firearms. BEFORE ATTACHING, INSPECTING, OR SERVICING A FIREARM-MOUNTED STAR★TRIO LONG GUN COMBO LIGHT

1. Engage the safety on the firearm if applicable
2. Remove the magazine from the firearm if applicable
3. Open the action and inspect the chamber to be sure it is empty

IT IS IMPERATIVE THAT SAFETY MEASURES BE EMPLOYED AT ALL TIMES WHILE HANDLING THE FIREARM.

BATTERY

WARNING: FIRE, EXPLOSION, BURN HAZARD

USE ONLY: qualified 3.7V 18650 or 3V CR123A batteries.

This product is not designed to use rechargeable CR123 cells.

The Star★Trio Long Gun Combo Light will function effectively when installed with the Star★Tactical 18650 USB Rechargeable 3.7V Protected Lithium-ion 3500mAh Battery.

LASER

*Runtime is defined as the amount of time between the initial switching of the flashlight and the decrease of brightness to 10% of the rated output on new batteries.

BATTERY INSTALLATION/REMOVAL

Uses one 18650 battery or two CR123 batteries. Unscrew the tailcap and remove depleted battery(s), insert fresh battery(s) positive end first, replace and tighten tailcap.

18650 USB BATTERY CHARGING

The Star★Trio Long Gun Combo Light may ship with an 18650 USB rechargeable lithium-ion battery with integrated charge port. The battery should be fully charged before its first use. To charge the 18650 USB battery, insert the micro-USB plug into the connector near the positive end of the battery. The battery may be left plugged into a micro-USB cable continuously; there is no danger of overcharge.

LED charge indicators

- Red: charging
- Blue: charged

FLASHLIGHT MOUNTING/REMOVAL

MAKE SURE THAT THE FIREARM IS UNLOADED AND THE BREECH IS OPEN. IT IS IMPERATIVE THAT SAFETY MEASURES BE EMPLOYED AT ALL TIMES WHILE HANDLING THE FIREARM.

The Star★Trio Long Gun Combo Light is designed to be rapidly and securely attached to or detached from any MIL-STD-1913 (Picatinny) rail with only the use of a hex wrench. To mount the light onto a rail

1. Use the hex wrench to unscrew the mount until the rail clamp is fully open and loose enough to place around the rail. NOTE: There is no need to continue loosening the screw beyond this point, as it will eventually fall off if rotated too many times.
2. Place the clamps around the rail at the preferred position.
3. Check for fit and alignment, then tighten the clamp by rotating the screw back in the opposite direction until the light is securely attached to the firearm.

To mount the remote pressure switch, either

(1) place the mount retaining clips at the preferred position on the rail then insert the remote pressure switch into the seat between the clips

OR

(2) apply the mounting adhesive to the bottom of the remote pressure switch then attach the remote pressure switch to any suitable position on the firearm.

VISIBLE LASER / INFRARED LASER SIGHTING

Windage: turn the windage screw to sight the visible laser/infrared laser right (clockwise) or left (counterclockwise).

Elevation: turn the elevation screw to sight the visible laser/infrared laser up (clockwise) or down (counterclockwise).

GENERAL OPERATION

Press the ON/OFF switch to toggle the Star★Trio Long Gun Combo Light on or off.

QUICK-SWITCH DIAL

Turn the dial to point at the desired operation mode.

REMOTE PRESSURE SWITCH

Constant-on: press circular locking switch until click

Momentary: press rectangular pressure switch

MAINTENANCE

Use a soft cloth and mild detergent to clean the glass lens and keep it free of dirt and grime.

Note: Always avoid aggressive cleaning solutions.
