

Learn Scuba Chicago (LSC) had its start in 2008 and opened its physical store front in 2013. On July 1, 2014 we applied to become a not for profit company. In July of 2015, we obtained our 501(c)3 Public Charity number, which we operate under today with a staff of over 30 strong!

LSC believes in giving back to our community in many ways. One of the ways we do this is through our Military Program. The LSC Military Scuba Program grants and scholarships to Military Members/Veterans and families who, without this financial assistance, would not be able to participate in scuba diving. This program gives our members the ability to participate in an activity that allows a sense of community, belonging and camaraderie again.

Scholarship applications are accepted throughout the year. The applications are reviewed by the Scholarship & Special Programs Committee and then passed along for final review, approval and granting of funds by the LSC Board of Directors. Scholarships may be awarded based on merit to cover the costs of the diving certifications only. This scholarship does not cover the costs of any gear required to participate in the program. A Grant Request for any required gear must be submitted under separate cover letter. The Grant Request will be given the same consideration and review by the committees listed above. The amount of the Scholarship (if any) may cover some or all of the costs, depending on the number of applicants and the amount of funding accessible. As a non-profit organization, LSC has limited funding available throughout the year. These funds are obtained throughout the year by events held by the Fundraising Committee. There is no guarantee that an applicant will receive such funds at the time of their request. Individuals who are not awarded a Scholarship or Grant at the time of their first submission may reapply 6 months after the date of their last submission for the Scholarship or Grant once again. All participants will be notified in writing within the following quarter of their application as to whether or not they will be awarded any funds.

Requirements for Eligibility:

-Must be a current Military Member or Veteran according to Federal Standards

- -If Veteran, must provide DD214 form; if current Military Member must show current ID
- -Must fill out a required application (form attached)*
- -Must have a completed and updated Medical and Liability Waiver form on file**

Once Approved:

-Must provide LSC with voluntary program assistance throughout the season which includes (certifications will not be provided until all requirements have been met):

-Must be able to provide at least one "Reach-Out-Reference" lead for additional recruitment possibilities (reach out references may consist of others who would be interested in joining the dive community as a participant -i.e. a friend, family member- or as a Partner – i.e. a University, a Program Director).

-Must assist on deck with at least one Military/Disability Discover Diver Day

-Must assist with at least packing for one pool and unpacking for one pool

-Must assist with at least packing for one quarry day
