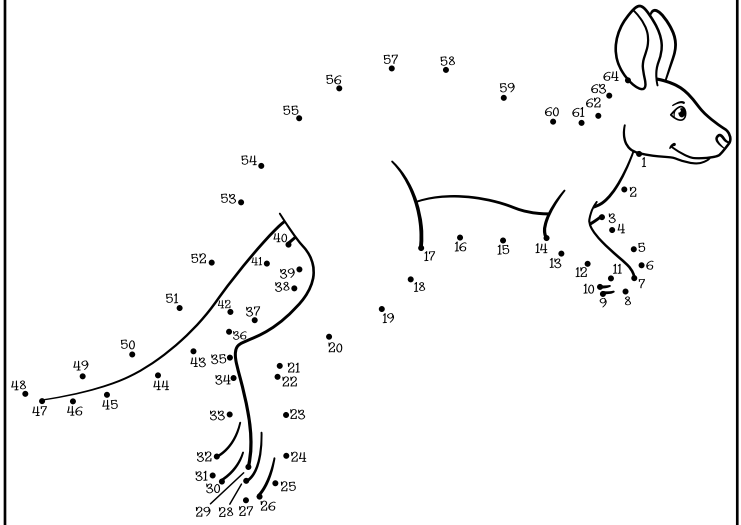


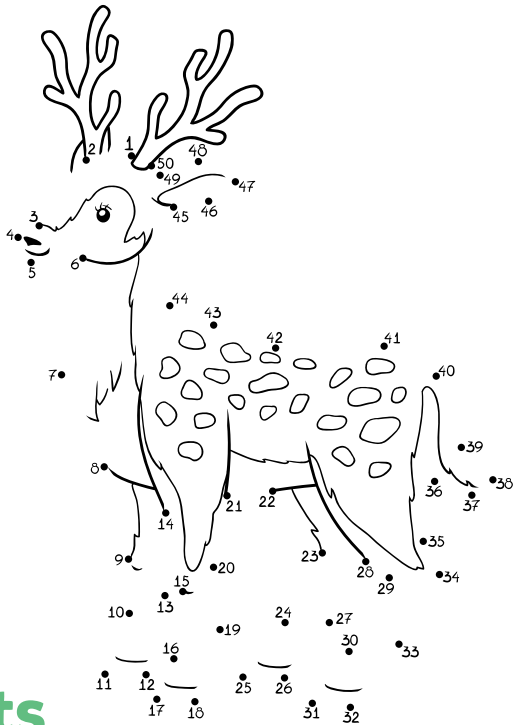
Facts

2. Adapted for jumping with powerful hind legs.



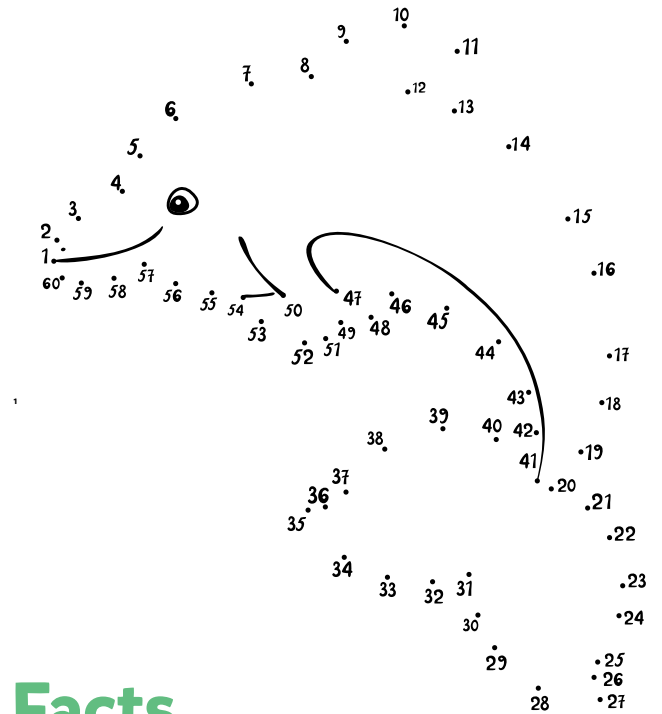
Facts

2. Kangaroos can make up to 30 foot long jumps.



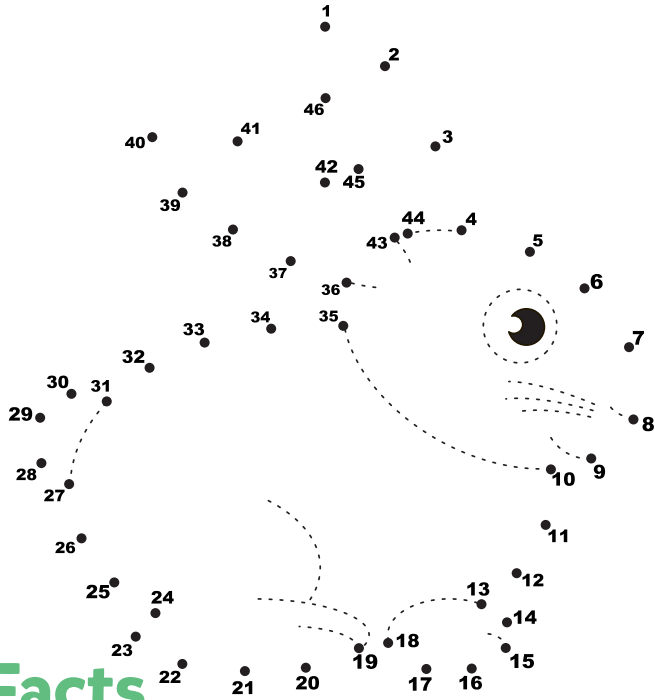
Facts

2. Specialised muscles for powerful jumps.



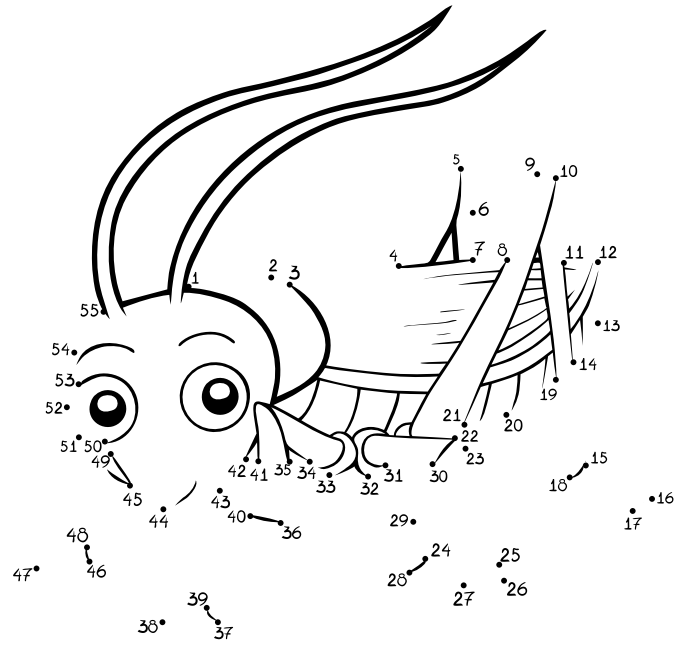
Facts

2. Use leaping for communication and play.



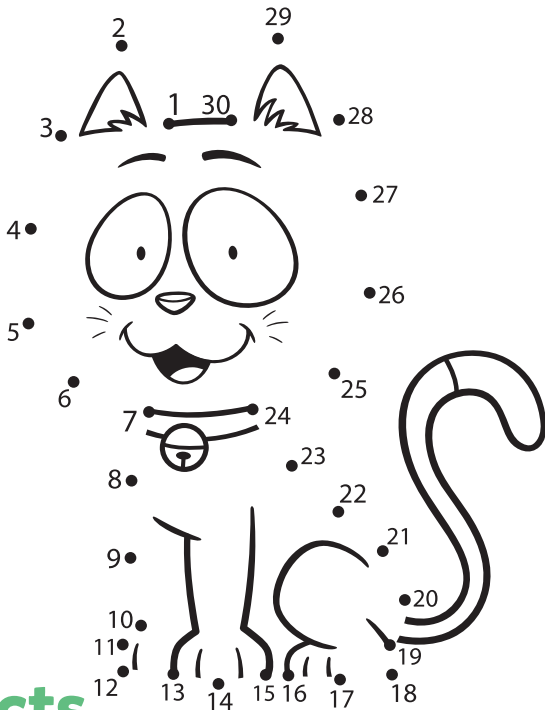
Facts

2. Strong hind legs enable powerful jumps.



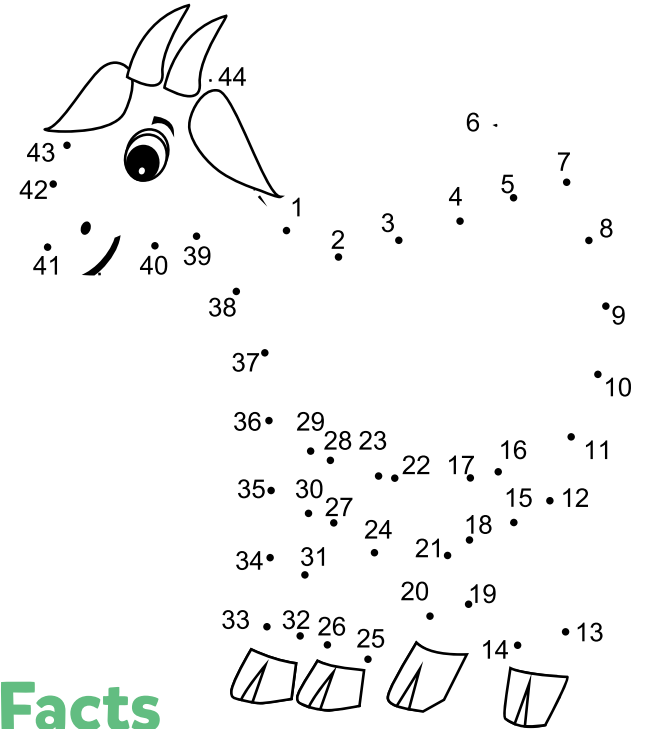
Facts
