



- 1. Can leap over 20 times their body length.
- 2. Adapted for jumping with powerful hind legs.




- 1. Red kangaroos are the largest kangaroo species.
- 2. Kangaroos can make up to 30 foot long jumps.




- 1. Capable of leaping up to 9 foot high and 29 foot long.
- 2. Specialised muscles for powerful jumps.




- 1. Can leap up to 16 foot out of the water.
- 2. Use leaping for communication and play.




- 1. Can leap up to 3 foot high and 9 foot long.
