1) Set everything up




2) Mold the toilet paper roll into a heart shape

4) Dip the roll into the paint




5) Start stamping. Make sure to avoid splatters



6) Set aside to dry






7) Use the paper to wrap a gift for your little valentine and write a cute note for them
