
# Wardrobes Mounting Instructions / Lalax

# Before you begin

Please read these instructions carefully before you start assembling your new wardrobe:

- Our wardrobes are easy to assemble, but you need to have basic skills in using tools such as an electric screwdriver and clamps.
- Make sure you have assembled the IKEA PAX cabinet frames correctly, according to IKEA's instructions.
- Do check carefully that the cabinet frames are straight to ensure a beautiful result.
- Assemble the wardrobe on a smooth and even surface, preferably on a thin carpet close to the area you
  are planning to place it. We also recommend having help, to minimize the risk of damaging any of the parts.






### Safety

Please always follow the safety instructions that apply to your IKEA products, especially when securing the cabinet to the wall. It's essential as the weight distribution changes when the doors are open. Use the anchor brackets provided with the IKEA cabinets.




1. Attach the IKEA cabinet frames using three screws. Drill three screws in between the holes of the frame in the front.


2. Install the side panels. They should stand out of the front of the cabinet frame by 25mm. Drill six screws in between the holes of the frame in the back and front.



3. Install the top panel with four screws per frame from the inside of the cabinet. In the front drill the screw in between the two holes. In the back drill the screw in front of the hole in the back. The top panel should stand out of the front of the cabinet frame by 25mm.



4. Secure the wardrobe to the wall using brackets and mounting screws, according to IKEA's instructions.



5. Install the hinges following IKEA's instructions. Then attach the doors.

6. Install the handles with the brass screws through the pre-drilled holes (4 or 5 screws depending on height) with a flat head screwdriver. Do not use a power drill.
