

## Orient to increase fans, LEDs production capacity

Orient Electric, a CK Birla Group company, plans to invest Rs 50 crore over the next two years to increase its fans and lighting manufacturing capacity.

It will spend around Rs 40 crore in setting up a facility for fan manufacturing in north India. Currently, Orient produces over 130 lakh fans per year at its two factories in Faridabad and Kolkata. It plans to add 50 lakh units capacity through the new facility.

Following the increase in demand for LED bulbs, Orient intends to shift its focus from CFL lights to LEDs and will invest around Rs 10 crore to increase the capacity of LED bulbs.
