

### **REPLACING THE FILTERS**

The ( ( ) will light up to remind you to replace the filters.

DO NOT wash/clean or reuse the filters. Only use Arovec AV-P152-RF replacement filters when changing the filters are required. This will help your air purifier to work effectively and last longer.

Replacement filters are available at www.arovec.com.au OR scan the QR Code.



### When to Replace the Filter

- It is best to change the filters every 6 months (4320 hours). You may need to change the
  filters more often or less often, depending on how much you use your air purifier and
  how much pollution is in the air.
- You do not need to wait for the ( \( \sqrt{\infty} \)) to turn on for changing the filters. You may need to change the filters if you notice any of the following:
  - Increased noise from the purifier when it is switched on.
  - No effective difference in air quality.
  - Decreased airflow.
  - Unusual odours.
  - Clogged filters.

### **Step for Replacing the Filters**

Follow these steps to replace the Filters:

- 1. Turn off and unplug the air purifier.
- 2. Turn the purifier upside down on a soft cloth. [Figure 1.1]
- 3. Turn the base cover anticlockwise to unlock the cover. [Figure 1.1]
- 4. Remove the base cover. [Figure 1.2]
- 5. Remove the used filters. [Figure 1.2]

- 6. Clean any remaining dust or hair inside the purifier with a vacuum cleaner. DO NOT use water or any liquids to clean the purifier. [Figure 1.3]
- 7. Remove the new filters from their packaging. [Figure 1.4]
- Place the new filters into the purifier. [Figure 1.5]
- Make sure the gray pre-filter is on top of the white HEPA filter.
- Make sure the white tabs are pointing upward.




- 8. Put the base cover back on. [Figure 1.6]
- 9. Turn the base cover clockwise to the lock position. [Figure 1.7]





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**Resetting the Air Purifier After Filter Replacement** 

You will need to reset the air purifier in two conditions.

- 1. If the filters were replaced after the ( ) light up:
  - Turn on the air purifier.
  - Press and hold ( ) for 3-5 seconds.
  - The ( ) light should turn OFF, which indicates that the purifier has been reset.
- 2. If the filter were replaced before the (  $\sqrt[6]{3}$ ) light up:
  - Plug in the air purifier after filter replacement, but do not turn on the air purifier.
  - Press and hold ( '\overline{\sigma'}) for 3-5 Seconds, to light up the ( '\overline{\sigma'}).
  - Press and hold again ( (55)) for 3-5 seconds, to turn OFF the ( (55)). the reset is now complete.
  - You can turn ON and use the air purifier with the new filter.
