


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STRAIGHT DESK ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTION




Attach the extendable beam to the end legs. Make sure the beam is mounted closer to the back of the legs. Open side of the beam should face the front on a single desk. Use a nylon hammer to hit the beam down into place.



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



INLINE DESK 2POD ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTION




Attach the extendable beam to the end legs and the inline legs as per above. Make sure the beam is mounted closer to the back of the legs. Open side of the beam should face the back of the desk. Use a nylon hammer to hit the beam down into place.








BACK TO BACK 2POD ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTION


STEP 1



Attach the extendable beam to the end legs and the inline legs as per above. Make sure the beam is mounted closer to the back of the legs. Open Side of the beam should face the back of the desk. Use a nylon hammer to hit the beam down into place.




Place the table top on to the frame, then attach centre screen to it, then place desk top on the frame. As per above.



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



BACK TO BACK 4POD ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTION





Place 2 table tops on one side of the frame as per above.




Install desk tops on other side. Extend beams out so end legs a line with the edge of the desk tops. Attach end leg frames and extendable beams to the desk top using bolt B. (Desk tops will be pre-drilled for the legs.) Using the bolts supplied with the beam, Install 2 bolts front and back of each beam as per above.






CORNER WORKSTATION with 90degree corner leg ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTION



Attach 90degree bracket to the 90degree back corner leg as per above, using bolts supplied with the bracket.



Attach extendable beams to the 90degree back corner leg and Balance end legs as per above, open side of the beam to face the back of the desk. Use nylon hammer to hit beam down into place. Using the bolt supplied with the beam, install 2 bolts front and back of each beam as per above.




Place desk tops on to the leg frame as per above. Extend beams out so end leg are inline with the edge of the desk top. Desk top will be predrilled for the legs. Attach desk top to the legs and beams using the wood screws supplied.






CORNER WORKSTATION with 3 End Legs ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTION






Attach the return leg beam to the beam to beam connecter bracket as per above.

Extend the beams out to match the desk top supplied, align the legs up with the front , back and ends of the desk top, place the table top on to the frame, attach the table top to the frame using the wood screws provided. Install 2 bolts front and back of each beam as per above.



3 POD 120DEGREE ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTION




Attach 120degree bracket to the 120degree back corner leg as per above, using Bolts supplied with the bracket.



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Attached Extendable beams to the 120degree back corner leg and Balance end legs as per above, open side of the beam to face the centre of the pod. Use nylon hammer to hit beam down into place.



Install screens as per above. Attached end legs frames and extendable beams to the desk top using the wood screws. (Desk tops will be pre-drilled for the legs). Using the bolt supplied with the beam, Install 2 bolts front and back of each beam as per above.

FACTSHEET CARE & MAINTENANCE



GENERAL CARE – INFORMATION

- Avoid scourers and abrasives as they will damage the surface.
- Don't place hot objects, electrical appliances or pots straight from the oven or cooker onto your laminate surface.
- Don't cut on the laminate surface.
- Keep waxes and polishes well away as they dull the natural shine.
- Do not use strongly acidic, alkaline cleaners or bleach for normal cleaning as these might etch the surface.

GENERAL CARE – STREAKS

Streaky marks sometimes show on dark colours after cleaning. An all-purpose cleaner such as Mr. Muscle Surface & Glass or Ajax Spray n Wipe usually removes them.

GENERAL CARE – GREASE

Using a mild dishwashing detergent in water will remove greasy marks. Dab, wait and wipe away. Finish with an all-purpose cleaner such as Mr. Muscle Surface & Glass or Ajax Spray n Wipe.

GENERAL CARE – SPILLS

Laminate surfaces resist staining from most household chemicals. With some accidental spills however, prompt action is essential. Wipe off beetroot, grape and berry juices, first aid preparations, concentrated bleach, oven cleaners, dishwasher detergents, artificial dyes, hair colouring and solvent based pen ink immediately. Specialty glues such as Super Glue must also be removed straight away with acetone (nail polish remover).

GENERAL CARE – STAINS

If the stain won't budge with Mr. Muscle Surface & Glass, try methylated spirits or dab the stain with a diluted bleach mixture (1 part bleach to 8 parts water); leave for 3 minutes then wash off with water and dry. Finish off with Mr. Muscle Surface & Glass. Only as a last resort if a stain persists try 2 or 3 rubs with a crème cleanser or white toothpaste, wash and dry. Please note that bleach or these abrasive cleaners may irreversibly damage the laminate surface.

GENERAL CARE – SCRATCHES

Laminate surfaces will withstand normal wear and tear, but can be damaged by scratching or cutting with utensils, knives and unglazed pottery. Darker colours will show scratches more readily than lighter colours. In general, dark colours and high gloss surfaces require more care and maintenance than lighter colours or lower gloss colours. To minimise scratching, always place and lift objects from the surface – never drag or slide them across the surface.
