





## 3 FUNCTION CONTROL SWITCH



AUTO - Turns on standby mode, shredding starts when paper sheets are inserted into the feed opening.

OFF - Turns off power to shredder

REV - Shredder will rotate in opposite direction, forcing paper to exit at top.

Indicator Lights:
Power/Overload
Green = Power is On
Red = Feed Tray is Overloaded with Paper

#### Bin Full/Overheat

Blue = Waste Bin is Full Red = Motor is Overheated

## IMPORTANT SAFETY GUIDELINES

- Do not exceed maximum recommended number of sheets when feeding paper into shredder.
- Always unplug the shredder before cleaning the waste bin.
- Unplug the shredder if not in use for extended periods of time.
- Keep ties, jewelry, hair, etc. away from the shredder feed opening to ensure personal safety.
- Avoid touching the feed opening with hands.
- Keep aerosol products away from shredder as these can damage motor.
- Do not place near heat sources or in humid environment for extended periods of time.
- Place shredder far away from areas frequented by children and pets.
- Product is not intended for use by children (product is not a toy.)

## **OPERATION**

Read and follow all safety instructions before using the shredder. Your shredder can operate in either Auto-Feed Mode or Manual Feed Mode. The auto-feed slot can shred up to 60 sheets of paper at a time, whereas the manual feed can handle up to 6 sheets of standard paper at one time (or one credit card at a time).

#### Manual Feed Mode:

- 1. Slide the function switch to the AUTO position.
- 2. Put up to 6 sheets of paper into the manual paper feed opening and your shredder will switch on automatically.
- 3. To shred credit cards and small receipts make sure to insert them into feed opening by the area marked with the credit card icon. Only shred one credit card at a time
- 4. After shredding is completed, slide the function switch back to the OFF position.

#### Auto-Feed Mode:

- $1.\,Slide$  the function switch to the AUTO position.
- 2. Insert up to 60 sheets of paper into the auto-feed tray.
- 3. Make sure to remove all staples and paper clips prior to shredding as this may cause your shredder to jam. Only paper should be shredded through the autofeed tray.
- 4. Once paper is inserted into the feed tray, the motor will turn on. After several seconds, the shredding process will automatically begin, shredding 2-3 sheets of paper at a time until the feed tray is empty.
- 5. As soon as all the paper in the auto feed tray is shredded, the unit will go back into standby mode.
- 6. After shredding is completed, slide the function switch back to the OFF position.

## **EMPTY WASTE BIN**

- 1. Turn the shredder off and unplug the power cord from the electrical outlet.
- 2. Remove the shredder head from the waste bin by lifting the handle straight up.
- 3. Empty the waste bin.
- 4. Replace shredder head on waste bin.
- 5. Plug shredder power cord back into outlet.

## **CLEARING PAPER JAMS**

## Clearing Manual Feed Paper Jams:

To clear a paper jam from the manual feed opening, simply switch the function button to the reverse position (REV). The shredder will rotate the blades in reverse. Pull out the paper in the feed opening to clear the jam. Once the paper is removed, switch the function button back to the AUTO position and resume shredding.

### Clearing Auto Feed Paper Jams:

- 1. Slide the Power Switch to the OFF Position and unplug the shredder.
- 2. Locate the Panel Lock Knob on the top of the shredder, above the Power Switch and manual feed opening. Lift the handle on the Knob and rotate it to the right to unlock the Panel from the shredder. (There are instructions on the Panel to guide you.)
- 3. While holding the Knob in the unlocked position, gently lift and pull the panel away from the shredder. This will give you full access to the feed opening area.
- 4. Remove jammed paper.
- 5. To replace the Panel, twist the Knob to the unlocked position and hold it. Return the Panel to its original position, making sure that the side connection pins are properly inserted. Release the Knob and it will return to the locked position.

Note: The shredder will not power up if the panel is not properly seated and locked in place.

## **OVERHEAT PROTECTION**

Frequent or continuous use of the shredder may cause motor to exceed normal operating temperature. Your shredder has a built-in feature that will protect the motor if it begins to overheat, by automatically shutting off the shredder motor.

- In Auto-Feed Mode, the motor will automatically turn off after approximately 12 minutes of continuous operation.
- In Manual Mode, the motor will automatically turn off after approximately 5 minutes of continuous operation

At the top of the shredder, a red indicator light will turn on, letting you know that the shredder has overheated and needs to cool down. Unplug the shredder power cord from the electrical outlet and allow the motor to cool (approximately 60 minutes to completely cool down).

Once the motor has cooled, the red indicator light will turn off and the shredder will be ready for use.

Note: If the indicator light is blue, it means that the waste bin is full.

## TROUBLESHOOTING TIPS

PROBLEM: Unit does not power up.

CAUSE Shredder components are not properly installed or aligned.

SOLUTION: Make sure that shredder head is properly placed on the waste

basket. The shredder basket window should be aligned with the front of the lid. This unit has an automatic sensor that switches the shredder off when the shredder head is removed from the wastebasket. Locate the tab on the back of the shredder basket and make sure it is inserted into the opening on the lid. Make sure that the information panel on the top of the shredder is properly

attached. (See "Clearing Auto Feed Paper Jams" section.)

PROBLEM: Power turned off while shredding.

CAUSE: Motor overheated

SOLUTION: This shredder has a safety feature that will protect the motor if

it overheats by automatically shutting the motor down. If this happens, the Overheat indicator light will turn red. To reset, turn the shredder off and wait 30-60 minutes for the motor to cool down

PROBLEM: Paper is jammed and shredder does not run.

CAUSE: Too many sheets of paper are being fed into shredder at one time,

or paper pieces caught in blades.

SOLUTION: Press the "REV" button to clear paper from the blades..

PROBLEM: Shredder motor is making loud and/or irregular noises during

operation

CAUSE: Your motor or gears could be damaged.

SOLUTION: Please immediately stop use, unplug the machine and call

customer support for assistance.
