

# Early Spring Vegetables



**Beet Golden Detroit**

50 days to maturity. A vibrant-colored beet that does not bleed when cooked. The globe shaped roots are bright orange with gold flesh. The roots grows fast and retains its sweet flavor when large. Golden Detroit is excellent for pickling as it is very tender and mild. This beet is well suited for California climate.



**Celery Golden Self Blanching**

90 days to maturity. Golden Self Blanching is a very old variety that is a good keeper. The plants are stocky, solid and thick. The stalks are entirely self-blanching without any banking up or covering. Its ribs are yellow-white that is very pleasing to the eye. Add this celery to your dish for a crispy and sweet treat.



**Herb Arugula Wild**

An Italian favorite, Wild Arugula has a more pungent taste than regular arugula. The leaves are deeply lobed and contains a leaf shape like Mizuna. Wild Arugula does excellent in the heat and humidity.



**Pea Golden Sweet**

60 – 70 days to maturity. The gold standard for yellow shelling peas. This yellow pod snow pea grows to be about 3 inches long and contains a sweet taste. The vines are vigorous and can grow up to 6 feet long. Golden Sweet can be eaten raw in salads or steamed as a vegetable.



**Kale Black Magic**

60 days to maturity. A cool season green that is filled with nutrients and flavor. Black Magic is a cool season green that produces large narrow dark green leaves that are great for baby kale, frying into chips or sautéing. Black Magic consist of a rich flavor which improves with frost. Also known as Dinosaur Kale or Tuscan Kale.



**Swisschard Canary**

60 days to maturity. This beautiful swisschard is a wonderful mix of yellow and dark green. The stem and veins are a bright yellow that merges into dark green savoyed leaves. Canary is great eaten fresh or steamed. Add it to your salad and it will have people talking about the bright colors.



**Carrot Solar Yellow**

60 days to maturity. Completely yellow 6 to 7 inch roots. These tapered roots have a refreshing sweet flavor. Solar Yellow are crisp while still being juicy. Making them an excellent choice for juicing, soups, and sauces while maintaining a golden coloring



**Radish Helios**

30 – 35 days to maturity. Named after the Greek god of the sun, this olive-shaped radish is bright yellow with white flesh. It is truly one of the most beautiful radish. Not only is Helios a beauty, it is also tasty with a sweet and mild flavor.
