Cinderella's Carriage F1

2014 Regional AAS Winner. 'Cinderella's Carriage' is a dream come true for any princess-loving child who wants to grow their own fairy tale pumpkin. This bright reddish-orange pumpkin is the first hybrid Cinderella-type on the market which results in a higher yield, as well as Powdery Mildew resistance. Robust and vigorous vines produce large fruits ranging from 25-35 pounds, creating a whole grouping of carriages for all the princesses in your family!

Mini Harvest Blend F1

Created for the ornamental mini pumpkin market, with excellent edible qualities. 'Bumpkin' has a semi bush plant habit with excellent yield potential. 'Jack Be Little' with dark orange skin and strong dark green handles. 'Gooligan' is a 'Baby Boo' hybrid, plants set high numbers of unique white pumpkins. 'Hooligan' is a bicolored 'Jack Be Little' hybrid with orange and white mottled fruit. Grow these three varieties for a great novelty mixture.

Harvest Ace F1

'Harvest Ace' F1 will meet the need of the 20-25 lb. pumpkin market. Maturing in only a hundred and five days, this hybrid has a good dark green handle with bird's foot attachment. This trailing pumpkin is very dark gold with distinctive ribs and has a uniform shape that is deep round to slightly tall. With Powdery Mildew tolerance 'Harvest Ace' produces high yields for either the packaging or field sales.

Casper

90 days to maturity - A white skinned ornamental pumpkin with thick orange flesh of excellent eating quality, 8-12 inch diameter, fruit weigh 10 to 16 pounds. Casper's skin has less blueing than many other white varieties. The handle is tan with a corky texture.



Squash Honeynut

Small personal size butternut with trailing vines, matures in 110 days. These mini butternuts love to grow in a container with support or on a fence line. The very nutty and tasty fruit are dark orange and an excellent source of vitamin A. Bred by Cornell University for Powdery Mildew resistance and exceptional sweet flavor. Internal color is a deep burnt orange with 13 plus brix. miniature hubbard squash.

Squash Mini Magic F1

'Mini Magic' is a component blend of three miniature hubbard squash. All varieties are 3-5 pound fruit and have semi bush habits. You can purchase this variety mixed or separately.
