

Gourds Galore



Maranka

125 days to maturity. This dark green gourd is 10 – 16 inches long and weighs 7 – 14 pounds. Maranka is shiny with a hard shell that has knobby protrusions and a curved neck that tapers at the stem end. It will grow straight however, if supported. This beautiful gourd is edible when at 8 inches in length.



Dancing and Spinning

90 – 100 days to maturity. A small gourd at just 3 to 5 inches long. Years ago children would carry these gourds in their pockets to play with at school where they would spin them on their desks. Dancing and Spinning hardens as they dry and are also great for fall decorations.



Cuccuzi

This Italian edible gourd can grow up to be 48 inches long but can also be harvested when young and used as a summer squash. Cuccuzi has a smooth pale-green skin with a creamy-yellow flesh. They are very ornamental and interesting. Decorating with Cuccuzi will definitely get a conversation going.



Blister

A unique gourd, Blister looks exactly like how it sounds, an apple shaped gourd covered in warts. These 9 by 12 inches fruit weighs 4 - 7 pounds. Set them out as part of your display for a little fun this fall. People will be talking about these light green gourds.



Harvest Wings Bush F1

A beautiful blend of small ornamental gourds that would look great with your fall display. Containing green, yellow, white and orange fruits with multiple shapes and contours, these beauties will be a delight to have. They are an abundant set on a small semi-bush plant.



Yugoslavian Fingers

Just as the name states, these gourds have 8 to 10 fingers that extends towards the blossom end, making ribs on the sides of the fruits. These cream-colored gourd weigh about 4 - 5 pounds. They can be harvested when young and used as a summer squash. Yugoslavian Fingers is tasty as a winter type and ornamental.



Speckled Swan

105 days to maturity. These graceful swan necked gourds weighs 3 pounds and are approximately 3 inches wide, 16 inches tall. Their round base is topped off with a thick curved neck that has a bulbous tip. With their deep green color and speckles of light green all around, Speckled Swan is perfect for displaying.



Turks Turban

100 days to maturity. A very old variety from France, Turk's Turban is beautiful with red, orange, green and white stripes with a scarlet top. Its flesh is orange and thick, perfect for baking and stuffing. Being 8 – 12 inches in diameter and weighing 5 pounds, this gourd is great for fall displays and resembles a small orange butternut with a colorful turban.
