This is a mixture of every color of cherry tomato there is. Colors range from red, black, brown, white, yellow, orange, bicolor and pink. Choose the best tasting and brightest colors for your own custom blend, if you wish.

Open pollinated blend of the full flavored tomatoes. We have chosen these varieties from many blind taste tests. Our customers from all over the world have passed on their best of the best. We have created this blend for home gardeners and chefs.

80 days to maturity. Beautiful heirloom, indeterminate, 6 foot plants, ribbed shouldered golden fruits with streaks of red and pink running through the flesh, some weigh up to 2 pounds, can have cracks and catfacing but has superb flavor. Many of the fruit bottoms have a red to pink blush on the skin.

Very early maturing in just 55 days. Exceptionally sweet, round, bright yellow cherry tomato has a 1-inch diameter. This 24" bush tomato can literally have dozens of delicious ripe fruit set on its multiple branch clusters. Bred by James Baggett from Oregon State University.

Bred by the legendary Luther Burbank in 1915, this tomato has it all. Stocky determinate plants will reach 30 to 36 inches. Red, slightly round fruit, weigh 6-8 ounces with some of the highest levels of amino acids tested.

Developed in the 1930's by M.C. Byles "Radiator Charlie". He sold his hand crossed, custom bred tomatoes plants for \$1 each. This large indeterminate plant bears huge 2 plus pound pink tomatoes. It is said, after six years of plant sales he paid of his mortgage of \$6000.00.

Of course Amish in origin form Lancaster county in Pennsylvania. This long pear shaped paste variety produces 10 ounce red fruits on a vigorous indeterminate plant. Prized for their versatile uses. Excellent used for canning or eaten fresh.
