




ROOT VEGETABLES




Cosmic Purple

58 days to maturity. 7 inch roots which have smooth purple colored skin and a coreless orange color within. The roots are very sweet and tasty, Tops are 10 inches. Purple coloring remains after cooking.




Bambina

61 days to maturity. Baby gourmet carrot, color develops quickly, can pull early, 4 in. cylindrical blunt roots, very small core, smooth skin, deep orange color, small week tops, developed for canning & pickling whole, must be harvested early.



Parisian

58 days to maturity. Uniform deep red orange, smooth, nearly coreless, 1 in., round planet shaped, very sweet, 9-10 in. tops, fine grained crisp flesh, Useful home variety and fresh market variety, holds color for freezing.




Solar Yellow

63 days to maturity. 6-7 inch roots, completely yellow carrot, very refreshing sweet flavor, extra crunchy and juicy. Yellow color adds beauty to any rainbow mixture.




Lunar White

60 days to maturity. Tall vigorous plants, heavy crop, grows totally under ground, almost completely coreless, very mild flavor, delicious when picked small great for added color in rainbow bunches.



Atomic Red

65 days to maturity. 11"x 1.5" long tapered bright red roots. High in Lypocene, a precursor to beta carotene, said to be a preventative of several types of cancer. Crispy roots that taste wonderful cooked, color tends to be more intense when cooked, slightly washed out when raw.



Rainbow Blend

A Kaleidoscope of Carrots, colorful mixture of five varieties of baby carrots. Plant Atomic Red, Bambino, Cosmic Purple, Lunar White, and Solar Yellow to create perfect bunches of baby carrots. Great for all specialty and farmers markets.



Purple Plum


Twenty five days to maturity. Bright purple skin, firm white flesh, crisp, sweet and mild all season roots. Never pithy or hot, very hardy variety and adaptable in many locations and climates.





Pink Summercicle

Thirty days to maturity. Originally from Northern China, pink red roots which are five to six inches long. Interior is crisp white and very sweet. Edible long pink stems are picked and used in stir fry. Very adaptable variety, best when sowed in early spring or fall.



Easter Egg Blend

Beautiful round radishes, Pink Beauty, Purple Plum, White Beauty, German Giant, and many others can create a perfect blend. Radishes are a great short crop for specialty markets.




Albino

Round white beet with delicious sweet flavor, smooth bolt resistant roots. Tops are plain white and do not bleed like red beets. Excellent novelty item for pickling and cooking. Tops are a good replacement for Lutz Green Top for bunching, since they are totally green in color.



Red and Gold Blend


Fifty/fifty blend of Detroit Dark Red and Golden Detroit. Both have dual use for roots and tops. Each has similar maturity dates estimated at fifty-five days. This blend offers the best of both worlds for gardeners and market growers.



Golden Globe


Golden Globe

Fifty days to maturity. Pale yellow three to four inch roots. Globes are sweet, tender, mild, and have a deep golden-yellow flesh, very fine flavor. The medium-sized cut leaf tops, keeps well, nice to cook for greens. Roots tastes more like a rutabaga than an early summer turnip, excellent for home gardens.



Tendersweet

Seventy five days to maturity. Uniform deep red orange roots, are smooth, nearly coreless, ten inch, tapers to reach point, very sweet, eighteen inch tops, leaf stems are tinged with purple fine grained crisp flesh. Useful home variety, holds color for freezing and cooking.



Confetti Blend

Confetti Blend

Twenty five days to maturity. Fast maturing, colorful blend of red, white and bi colored radishes with remarkable flavor, a beautiful addition to any assortment. These classic bright colors are perfect for any grower or gardener.




Long Scarlet Cincinnati

Thirty days to maturity. Long tapered deep red roots, six to seven inches long. Roots have crisp tender white flesh, medium tops, for bunching. Very heavy yielding variety excellent for home gardens and specialty markets.




German Giant

Thirty days to maturity. Very large round red radish heirloom from Germany, scarlet-red skin, crisp white slightly pungent flesh, harvest from marble to baseball size, will not get woody or spongy.



Culinary Blend

A tasty blend of yellow, white and orange carrots. Each variety is suited both for baby root production and cooking. This blend is excellent roasted in the oven. All three varieties are prized for flavor and color. Plant this mixture in your garden or fields.




White Beauty

25 days to maturity. Pure white skin, firm flesh stays crisp for a long time, dark green strong med-sized tops, larger than most early globe types, plant either spring or fall.



Watermelon

Large white rooted radish with green shoulders. The inside flesh is red to pink and is very sweet and crisp. Large tops for ease in picking. Pick these babies while the are colorful and still small.




Golden Detroit

65 days to maturity. Round orange roots turn gold-yellow when cooked, does not bleed, roots grow fast, retains sweet flavor when quite large, excellent for pickles, very tender and mild, well suited to California climate but well adapted for many climates



Pink Beauty

27 days to maturity. Rose-pink color, round & smooth, small taproot, unique flavor, crisp white flesh, grows large but stays mild & not pithy, adds a new color to relish trays.



Chioggia

60 days to maturity. Italian heirloom, alternating red and white concentric rings make it a real specialty item, mild flavored greens used raw or cooked.



Black Spanish Round

28 days to maturity. Dark black skin, firm white flesh, crisp, sweet and mild all season, never pithy or hot, hardy and adaptable. Very unique heirloom variety.
