

Oregon Sugar Pod

66 days to maturity. 28-30 inch vines produce 4-5 inch stringless, smooth edible pods. Heavy yields for both fresh market and freezer use. PM, Fusarium Wilt, PEMV resistant.




Hearts of Gold

79 days to maturity. Aromatic sweet deep orange flesh very thick and firm, small cavity, nearly round 6 x 5 in. diameter, 3-4 lbs., heavily netted, medium ribs, quite vigorous, very productive, blight resistant, ships well for moderate distances.



Royalty Purple Pod

55 days to maturity. Purple bushes with short runners and purple flowers, bright-purple stringless slightly curved round 5-6 inch pods, cook to green, Mexican bean beetles avoid it, buff seeds germinate in cold wet soil, very tender, for home gardens and specialty markets.



Golden Cal Wonder

70 days to maturity. Smooth blocky and blunt ended, 5 x 4 in. diameter, 4 lobed, light green to golden yellow, thick walled, very sweet and mild, 24-26 in. sturdy upright plants, sets continuously.



All Ocason


All Seasons

80 days to maturity. Compact stocky 20 inch plants, dark blue-green solid medium green heads, few side shoots, For production all year round as the name states. All Seasons was selected for heat and cold tolerance. This variety may work when many others will not.

Spring Rapini


Sixty days to maturity. Plant early in spring or fall, harvest before hot weather, no central head but many strap-leaves and side shoots, looks like mustard with many dimesized green buds, early European branching variety for tops and tender flower shoots, will not over winter in cold climates.



Bush Blue Lake 274

Fifty five days to maturity. Dark-green round creaseback six inch pods, slow seed development, long season. Twenty inch tall plants, resistant to BCMV & NY15, white seed, heavy yields, duel use processor and fresh market type. Can be mechanical harvested, fine texture and quality, seed and fiber slow to develop, widely adapted.




Detroit Dark Red

Fifty days to maturity. Nearly round globe shaped, blood-red three inch solid roots. Main season crop used canning and cooking for home gardens, all purpose, prolific, the standard for beets.




Chinese Giant

Ninety days to maturity. Extremely large almost square fruits, six inch blocky bell peppers, medium thick sweet mild flesh. Dark green fruits change to bright cherry red, produces early, ideal for home gardens. Heirloom pepper from the turn of the century.




Jack O Lantern

One hundred days to maturity. Smooth orange skin, with shallow ribs, nine by ten inch fruits which weigh ten to fifteen pounds. The medium thick sweet fine grained pail orange flesh is good for cooking.



Ornamental Mixture

Seventy days to maturity. Six to seven feet tall with five inch blooms, from pale lemon yellow to dark red flower colors. Free flowering, multiple branched and flowered, plants with strong stems are ideal for cut flowers or borders.




Waltham Butternut

One hundred days to maturity. Very popular butternut, uniform shape and size, good interior texture and color. Fruit are eight by four inches, and weighs three to five pounds. The smooth light tan skin, thicker cylindrical necks, and small seed cavity, protect rich dry yellowish orange flesh, with nutty flavor. The vigorous vines, produce high yields, excellent for storage.




Red Express

Fifty three days to maturity. Very early to head. The first super early open pollinated red cabbage to be released in years, small plant frame, dense, solid, oval heads, dark purple red color, two to three pounds, bred for Canada & Northern US. Red Express is very adaptable to many locations.




Pink Beauty

Twenty seven days to maturity. Rosepink color, round and smooth, small taproot, unique flavor, crisp white flesh, grows large but stays mild and not pithy, adds a new color to relish trays and bunches.




Parrot

Dark green semi savoyed leaves contrast nicely with the white sturdy stems. Parrot works excellent as a green chard for baby leaf production as well as for bunching. 
Habanero Orange

Matures in one hundred days. Native to the Yucatan, thirty six inch plants, tapered lantern-shaped one to two inch pods, thick wrinkled light-green flesh ripens to a lovely golden-orange, reportedly 1,000 times hotter than Jalapeno, 200,000 Scoville heat units, slow to germinate, must be grown in warm moist conditions, a Caribbean favorite used in sauces.



Big Rainbow

90 days to maturity. Heirloom, indeterminate, 6 ft. plants, huge rib shouldered golden fruits with streaks of red running through the flesh, some weigh up to 2 lbs., subject to cracks and catfacing but has superb flavor.




Golden Detroit

60 days, Round orange roots turn gold-yellow whe cooked, does not bleed, roots grow fast, retains sweet flavor when quite large, excellent for pickles, very tender and mild, well suited to California climate but adaptable for many areas.




Basil Mixture


Crimson Sweet

85 days to maturity. Tough med-thick hard rind, light green with small dark green stripes, blocky, 12 x 10 in., 25 lbs., bright deep red flesh, high sugar content, few small seeds, white cream on bottom when ripe, shipping and local market, resistant to Fusarium Wilt 1 & 2, Anthracnose 1 & 3.




