#### Cinderella's Carriage F1

A lovely French heirloom hybrid with red to pink fruits are 10 to 12 inches deep and 18 to 22 inches in diameter. These magical Cinderella's Carriage pumpkins range from 15 to 25 pounds. The fruit are spectacular for fall color and decorations



Orange F1
This variety matures in 75 days. This orange heirloom hybrid selected from the Northeastern varieties grows on indeterminate vines. It produces large, deep globe orange beefsteak fruits with outstanding flavor that can produce up to 1-pound fruits. The orange interior color is exceptional and prized for soups and sauces.



### Santa Fe

it takes 25 days to baby leaf and 60 days to maturity. This variety features a beautiful, tender semi-butter head with bright-green leaves splashed with red. It is long standing and slow bolting. Santa Fe was selected in the Southwest and is very heat tolerant. The thick leaves are resistant to many insects.



#### French Garden

This variety matures in 51 to 65 days. A haricot vert type, this French bean variety grows on an 18-inch vigorous bush plant. The small pencil-thin, straight, dark-green pods are totally stringless. Pods measure 7 inches long and remain tender for an extended period of time. Try this French delicacy in your garden today.



## Peppermint Stick

Peppermint Stick is a unique bicolored celery for the home garden. This full flavored celery is perfect for any kitchen garden. The leaves and stalks can be used for fresh seasoning all year long. Peppermint Stick is very slow to bolt. Seeds also can be used for a flavorful spice.



### Wild Arugula

This variety takes 15 days to baby and 30 days to maturity. It is a slow bolting annual, 6 to 8 inches tall. Stalks and serrated leaves have mild spice flavor. It is standard in many baby leaf and braising mixes. Very prostrate growing and an excellent choice for cut-and-come



#### Goldie F1

Direct sowing is recommended. If transplanted for early flowers, sow in large six packs and transplant when plants are small, 2 to 3 inches, to avoid transplant shock. It takes 50 to 55 days to flower, brilliant, golden yellow double flowers that are light yellow. Stems are thick and vigorous with a height of 5 to 6 feet. Flower diameter is 12 to 15 inches.



### Pic a Little F1

A good pickling variety, Pic a Little features medium-green fruit that ranges from 5 to 6 inches, has small spines, and is very crisp. Plants are semi-bush and maintain good production when picked regularly. Harvest small at 1 to 2 inches for baby sweet gherkins.



### Window Box Yellow

This true container tomato only reaches 10 inches and has a huge amount of bright yellow cherry flavorful tomatoes. Just imagine planting this ornamental tomato as a border plant next to you other annual flowers.
