Triple Treat F1

No picnic is complete without Triple Treat! This seedless watermelon is the perfect icebox type with bright red flesh and a crispy texture. Triple Treat has a tiger-stripped rind that is very firm. This triploid watermelon is deliciously sweet and light. Weighing 8 to 10 pounds, Triple Treat is just the right size for your family on those hot summer days.



Triple Baby F1

Sixty-five days to maturity, Triple Baby F1 has a beautiful, shiny, black rind. Its flesh is a deep red color and weighs 7 to 8 pounds. Triple Baby is a seedless watermelon and a true icebox type. Enjoy this large, but personal size, seedless watermelon on a hot sunny day and feel refreshed!



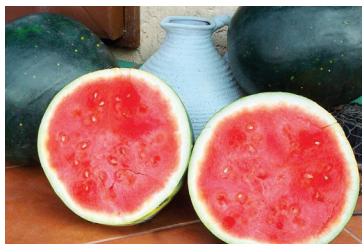
Triple Crown F1

Triple Crown is a seedless watermelon that is easy on the eyes and your taste buds! Triple Crown contains red flesh that is firm and crisp. Its rind is green with dark green stripes. Triple Crown is round and slightly elongated. Plant Triple Crown this year and enjoy an excellent yield of watermelon.



Baby Doll F1

Baby Doll is a yellow-fleshed diploid hybrid. Baby Doll is another watermelon that works well for your ice box and weighs 6 to 10 pounds. Baby Doll is easy to spot with its green rind and small dark stripes. Step outside of the norm with this yellow watermelon this season and you will not regret it!



Harvest Moon F1

First ever hybrid triploid to win an AAS award. A 2013 AAS national winner, Harvest Moon is similar to the popular heirloom variety, Moon and Stars. It retains the familiar dark green rind with yellow dots, but is seedless, ripens earlier, tastes better, and has a higher yield. Flesh is pinkish-red and sweet. A high-value item and excellent for bedding plant growers as a transplant item.



Triple Play F1

Triple Play is an early hybrid triploid watermelon, very sweet, and with bright red flesh. The rind color is light green with narrow, dark stripes. Triple Play weighs about 7 to 10 pounds and is an icebox-type watermelon. Take this seedless watermelon out on a picnic with your family and friends and everyone will enjoy it!



Legendary F1

Grow this sweet diploid watermelon if you want a high-yielding plant to enjoy throughout the season! Legendary will not disappoint with its number of fruit. It may not be seedless, but the seeds are small and dark colored. Legendary is long and contains large, dark green stripes. The flesh is red and also delicious! For a watermelon that you can savor through summer, Legendary is the one for you.



Triple Peacock F1

Surprise your guests at summer picnics with a 15- to 18-pound, seedless watermelon! Peacock is a triploid version of the heirloom elongated, black peacock type. Crack open this beauty on a sunny day, and everyone will fall in love with it. Peacock is prized for its deep red flesh and high sugar content.



Cal Sweet Bush

What a treat it is to grow a bush watermelon on your patio! This bright red fleshed, round, 5- to 7-pound, personal size watermelon has only 20-inch vines. They can be produced in any size garden or large container. Any urban gardener can grow fresh watermelons! The next time you think of summer and want to grow your own sweet watermelons, pick up this short-vined, AAS winner.
