Who does not love pickled cherry peppers? These small fiery wonders are half the size of a regular hot cherry fruit. The sturdy plant produces round ½-inch glossy red fruits. Cherry Mini Hot F1 is good for pickling or adding heat to any dish.



80 - 85 days to maturity. Back by popular demand, Pepper Cienfuegos Orange F1 is a high yielding orange habanero hybrid. If you are wanting uniformity, increased yield, and early maturity this is the habanero pepper for you. Its fruits are 1.5 inches by ¾ inch. Pepper Cienfuegos Orange F1 has a fruity hot flavor and ranges from 200,000 to 300,000 on the Scoville scale.

110 days to maturity. There is not a pepper that is too hot! Now arriving is our first hybrid ghost pepper with a heat level off the charts. With an estimated Scoville unit rating of 800,000 plus, these 2.5-inch pointed lanterns are a deep red color with smooth skin. Be the first to grow this extra hot, early maturing extreme pepper variety.



Pepper Hernandez F1 is a classic red Fresno pepper with a distinctive mild to medium heat. The 22 to 24-inch sturdy plants produce a large crop of conical, 2 to 3-inch bright red fruit. Pepper Hernandez F1 is prized for its thick red flesh that can be eaten fresh or roasted.



Pepper Mexican Sunrise F1 brings to the garden a full spectrum of colors, from lime green to yellow then orange and red as the fruit matures. The conical, pendant-shaped peppers are thick-walled and semi-hot. They can be eaten at any stage. Vegetable gardeners are sure to love this attractive fruit.



Mexican Sunset F1 is a compact, high-heat Hungarian hot wax pepper. The fruit sets early then prolifically throughout summer, bringing a variety of colors to the garden, as the fruits mature. These conically pointed peppers produce a thick-walled fruit, that can be eaten at any stage. Mexican Sunset F1 is excellent eaten fresh, baked, grilled, or pickled.



Our hybrid version of the very hot culinary wonder. Thai peppers are prized for their flavor and heat. These dark green peppers mature to red and are 100% smooth. The umbrella shaped plants protect the fruit completely from sunburn.
