USER'S GUIDE



The body of your Glen chimney is made up of high quality Stainless Steel and Toughened Glass.

SETTING UP YOUR CHIMNEY

The chimney must be mounted over the center of the cooking area. The minimum distance between the cooktop and the bottom of the chimney must be 750 mm.

Please ensure that the wall on which the chimney is being installed is level properly if not either get it leveled or install the chimney on a leveled $\frac{1}{2}$ " plywood

Attach the spigot to the hood using the four screws. In few models the spigot may already be mounted.

Fastening the chimney to the wall

Mark the position of the holes on the wall. Before drilling make sure that no wiring and tubes will be damaged. Drill two fastening holes, drive in the wall plugs and screw in the screws until their heads are about 6 mm from the wall.

Place the chimney to the wall in order to check that it seats properly. Then mark the positions of the two holes. Take it off from the wall now, drill the holes and fit the plugs. Place the hood once again to the wall, and introduce the screws from the inside of the appliance.



This chimney works only on exhaust mode. The maximum recommended length of ducting is 10 feet with a maximum of two bends. The suction power of the chimney considerably decreases in case the length of the number of bends increase further.

Note: The chimney has a 1400 m3 suction therefore the pipe must have minimum of 6" (150mm) dia.

Fix the Spigot with the help of the screws after matching the holes correctly.



Fix the exhaust / duct pipe and use the Electrical / Aluminum tape to seal it properly so that it doesn't move and there is no leakage of smoke.

Hold the Chimney, match the holes to peg board, fix the stop screw to the holes in the middle of peg board to avoid the Chimney turn over or drop down.

If you are installing hood cover, use the mounting bracket and screws to fix firmly.

The Exhaust / duct pipe to the outdoor, please take the pipe at least 30mm out and put a cowl cover to block the entry of birds. Also keep it at a downward angle to avoid rain water to drip in.

Electric connection

Make sure that the supply voltage ratings correspond with the specifications provided in the User's Guide.

MAINTENANCE

When performing maintenance operations, disconnect the plug from the socket.

Using the auto clean

Periodically you can Auto Clean the chimney. In this system the element around the housing heats up from the normal temperature to a max of 90° C. Due to the heat all the oil deposits in the blower and housing melts and collects in the oil cup. The oil cup can be removed and cleaned and fixed back. Chimney is ready for use.

The chimney surface should be cleaned with a damp cloth. No abrasive chemicals should be used.

Please note that your Chimney is made from Magnetic Stainless Steel and needs to be cleaned regularly and kept dry otherwise it may react to the moisture and dust and develop a rust kind of formation."

GESTURE FUNCTION

When you plug in all lights come on for 2 seconds and buzzer warns.

***** Swipe from left to right, Chimney starts on high speed.

® Swipe from right to left, Chimney switches off.

TOUCH FUNCTION

- To Switch ON/OFF touch the ${\tt 0}$ icon.
- Touch * and the LED will turn on touch again it will turn off.
- Touch \odot and the delay timer gets activated and chimney will switch off in 1 minute.
- When on standby touch delay ^(C) for 3 seconds and Auto clean System turns on. It's a 12 minutes cycle and after Auto clean system turns off 1 minute later chimney will switch off. In case you want to switch off Auto clean system while in operation long touch ^(C) for 3 seconds
- Speed 3: Touch (9) on Chimney starts at speed 3.
- Speed 2: Touch S on Chimney starts at speed 2.
- Speed 1: Touch (5) on Chimney starts at speed 1.
