

It's essential to inspect the hardware and each component of the product carefully as you unbox and get ready for assembly. To prevent any damage, make sure to place the items on a carpeted or padded surface while unpacking.






STEP 1:

Open the crates carefully, ensuring no tools come into contact with the product.


Open the dining table crate from the front face, with the rear of the carton supported so that the crate does not tip over.

Remove packaging and gently place the product on ground.




STEP 2:

Place the table base in the desired position in your room, making sure to lift, not drag the table base. The side with the metal top should be facing upwards.



STEP 3:
With someone to assist
you, unpack and lift the top
into place above the table
base, aligning the bolt holes
underneath.



STEP 4:
Using the supplied screws
and allen key, fasten the base
and top together from the
underneath. Periodically check
and retighten any fasteners, we
recommend every six months.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Taking a little extra care can significantly extend the lifespan of your furniture.

The information below serves as a general guideline, and is to be used for

optimal durability of your Rachel Donath furniture.

1. Stone and marble are naturally occurring organic materials, and can contain

variations in grain, colour or texture. These differences are to be expected as

individual characteristics of the material and inject personality into the item.

2. Wipe spills immediately with a damp, clean cloth to avoid staining, as stone

is naturally porous, the longer the spill remains, the harder it is to remove. We

recommend that you use mats and coasters to protect your marble and stone

from heat, scratches and permanent marks. Stone is a natural product of the

earth and must be cleaned with gentle cleaners. Do not use scouring cream

or scouring pads, as they may scratch the surface. Never use acidic or abrasive

cleaners or vinegar on either stone or marble surfaces.

3. Periodically also check and re-tighten any fasteners, we recommend every six

months.

By following these instructions, you can ensure the longevity and beauty of

your Rachel Donath furniture.
