

## Writing an abstract in APA format - college guide

### **Areas to be covered in Abstract**

You can write a well abstract once you have completed the research writing process because at this time you will have ample knowledge and clarity about the topic. Answer these questions in the abstract.

**State the problem.** Discuss why you have conducted the research and selected the topic?

**State the research hypothesis.** Describe what you have assumed about your topic?

**Highlight research methodology.** Which methods have you employed in your research process?

What was your sample and how you collected data?

**Discuss key findings and results.** What were your main findings and conclusion? Have your results been proved or rejected at [essay writing service](#)

**Summarize limitations and recommendations.** Is there any limitation or suggestion for future researchers?

**Keywords.** Use some important words as your keywords so that these can be used for indexing when you want to publish your paper. Keywords help others to find your topic. Use at least 3 keywords that are unique and tell something about your work.

### **APA Style for the Abstract**

There are some points that you should remember while formatting your paper. Write abstract after content page but before introduction. Use a running head and insert a number of pages in the right corner. The number should be in roman numerals. Page margins should be set to 1 inch. Use the bold and centralized “Abstract” heading at the top of the page. Start your content from the next line without indentation. You need to give Times New Roman style to your font with 12 font size and double line spacing. There should be no heading. The maximum word count should not be more than 250 for **APA format**. Use 3 to 5 keywords at the end of the abstract with an italicized heading” *Keywords:*” make sure to write all keywords in lowercase letters. Commas should be used to show separate words.

Before submission do ask someone to thoroughly read your abstract. Is it clear and presenting the whole summary? I would rather suggest having your abstract checked by the proofreader from any [essay writer service](#) . Receive the feedback from them and improve your paper before submission. It should be in academic style without vague ideas. The grammatical mistake should not be there in the text and there should be consistency in the style.
