How to Play

Hold the tambourine in your nondominant hand and wrap your fingers around the frame.

Strike the tambourine with your

dominant hand or use a beater

as quickly or slowly as you want.





Tambourines in many cultures are used by dancers in religious ceremonies or in entertainment.



Traditionally made of a wooden hoop with jingles attached, often with a head or soft shell. The jingles are referred to as 'zils'.



Mozart was among the earliest western composers to include the tambourine in his compositions.

Play around with different techniques - twist your wrist from left to right to make a sustained jingling sound.
