For the premium ribbed beef market Rebelski is the most authentic deep, shiny red internal and external colored tomato. Because of its ribbed fruit shape and high amount of trusses it is a very reliable summer variety, with firm fruit, excellent shelf life and deep short calyx.

• Due to its beautiful ribbed shape and the high number of bunches per stem, this breed is one of the most cultivated varieties in the Netherlands and Belgium. If grafted, Rebelski should be pinched on the second true leaf and it is not recommended to pinch on cotiledons.
