


FIXING A SEAM OR SMALL HOLE




STEP 1:
Turn the garment inside out and expose the hole.
Turning the fabric inside-out gives you better
access to the hole, and also makes it so that when
you stitch it up, the stitch will be invisible



STEP 2: Make the first stitch at one end of the hole. Pinch the edges of the hole together, so that they're aligned on the inside of the garment. Then, insert the needle about 2 mm from the edge at one end of the hole.



STEP 3: Move the needle back and forth through the fabric to create stitches about 2-3 millimetres long.



STEP 4: Insert the needle under the thread of your last stitch and pull it tightly to make a knot. Tie the thread through another loop to double knot the stitch. Trim the excess thread.
