Although those items are not shown on the pictures, this insert has enough room to store them. However, this instruction might show empty or partial empty boxes.




Boxes for Miniatures

These boxes will store almost all miniatures with small bases (Dadabee will not fit and is stored somewhere else).

Slide the miniatures into the slots. All slots have the same size. Be careful – some miniatures will only fit into the slots in one or two positions.


You should be able to place four miniatures in each slot. In some cases (i.e. Goobly) only three or (i.e. Peek-A-Round) two miniatures will fit.

See the following page for a closer look!



These pictures show how closely the miniatures can be arranged. However, this is not necessary. There are currently 42 empty places but only 26 miniatures are missing in the pictures. Feel free to place some of the miniatures farther apart, if it becomes to complicate to place them.

Please note #1: The fourth side is not shown, as it is currently empty. **Please note #2:** The miniatures in the middle box not seeming to fit is just a result of perspective when taking pictures.



Box for Big Miniatures

The following miniatures are placed here:

- 1. Crackin' Jim
- 2. Crabby Meg
- 3. Omega Launcher
- 4. Bulldozer
- 5. Zenith Queen
- 6. Uber Transport

Please note that Mountain Peek is placed in a different box.



Token Box

- 1. Portal Tokens
- 2. Robot Level Tokens
- 3. Victory Tokens
- 4. Wound Tokens
- 5. Door Tokens
- 6. Turret Tokens
- 7. Counterbases
- 8. Quest Tokens
- 9. Stimpack Tokens
- 10. Robot Part Tokens
- 11. Recharge Tokens
- 12. Hoverboard Tokens



Upgrade Token Box


- 1. Level 3 Deck
- 2. Level 2 Deck
- 3. Level 1 Deck
- 4. Armory & Scenario Reward Deck
- 5. Starter Deck



Card Boxes

- 1. Big Cards
- 2. Small Cards
- 3. Medium Cards


There is a special divider that can be placed in the Card Box for Big Cards if you don't own all expansions or if you are not using sleeves.



Plastic Token Box (optional)

If you own the Plastic Token Pack and / or the Wound Token Pack, these items are placed in these two boxes.

- 1. Victory Tokens
- 2. Wound Tokens
- 3. Empty / Reserve
- 4. Robot Part Tokens
- 5. Quest Tokens
- 6. Hoverboard Tokens
- 7. Recharge Tokens
- 8. Stimpack Tokens




Boxes for Miniatures & Dice

- 1. Robot Miniatures
- 2. Mountain Peek & Dadabee
- 3. Dice

Depending on how you assemble the robots, they might be too tall for the box. Make sure to check their height and lay them on their side, if necessary.

Please note that only the ten standard dice are place in this box. Any additional dice are store in a different box.



3D Terrain Box (optional)

- 1. 3D Doors
- 2. 3D Turrets
- 3. 3D Turrets & Terminals



Additional Dice Box (optional)

This Box is used to store the Additional Dice



To store the components, you will need one big and one small box.

Start with the big one and place the Token Box in one of the corners.

Make sure it is exactly orientated like in the picture.



Place both boxes for miniatures and dice on top of the Token Box like shown. Make sure both brackets on the lower box are pointing to the outside.



Place the Card Box for small and big cards on top of the Token Box. Make sure the small cards are facing away from you. Place the Box for big Miniatures next to it.



Place the Card Box for medium cards like shown.



Place both Boxes for Miniatures like shown.



Component Storage #6

Now take the second box. Place the Map Tiles like shown.



Place the Upgrade Token Box next to the map tiles. Place the Shuttle Tokens between the Upgrade Token Box and the game box.



Component Storage #7a - Only applicable if you own the optional extra boxes! Otherwise go to page 25.

Place the Plastic Token Boxes and the boxes for 3D Terrain and Additional Dice like shown in the picture.



Component Storage #8a - Only applicable if you own the optional extra boxes! Otherwise go to page 25.

Place two Campaign Sheets on top of the Map Tiles.



Component Storage #9a - Only applicable if you own the optional extra boxes! Otherwise go to page 25.

Place three (not all four!) Player Dashboards on top of the other components.



Component Storage #10a - Only applicable if you own the optional extra boxes! Otherwise go to page 25.

Place the remaining components evenly on top of everything else.



Component Storage #7b - Only applicable if you do not own the optional extra boxes! Otherwise go to page 21.

Place the spacer between the Upgrade Token Box and the Map Tiles. It is symmetrical, so don't worry about orientation.



Component Storage #8b - Only applicable if you do not own the optional extra boxes! Otherwise go to page 21.

Place three Campaign Sheets on the Map Tiles and one Campaign Sheet and the Robot Dashboards on the Upgrade Token Box.



Component Storage #9b - Only applicable if you do not own the optional extra boxes! Otherwise go to page 21.

Place the remaining Instructions and Player Dashboards on top.

Depending on the option you have chosen and which expansions you own, you might need to rearrange those items a little bit.
