

Teddy Bears' Picnic Party Ideas



1

Bear name badges

When the children arrive, give them a piece of card and string, so they can create a name badge lanyard for their bear.

2

Wear bear ears

The grown-ups cut out a long strip of thick paper about 4cm high and the right length to wrap around a child's head. Cut out two semi circles about 5cm height, for the ears. Decorate and colour the bear headresses. Glue or selotape the ears to the long strip to create the headdress.

Create an outfit for your bear

Using spare pieces of fabric, ribbon, paper or magazines, children can create an outfit for their bear. Get as creative as possible!

Pass the Bear

Just like pass the parcel! Children sit in a circle and pass a bear while the music plays. When the music stops, the child holding the bear is out and receives a small prize.

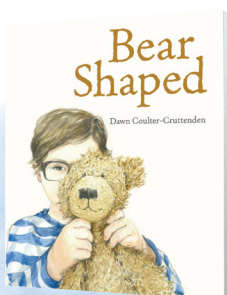
Teddy Bear Hunt

Print and cut out photos of bears and write the bear's name underneath. Hide them around the party, and give each child the name of the bear they need to look for. Encourage children to help their friends find their bears too.

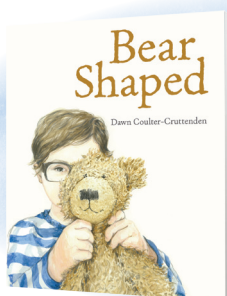

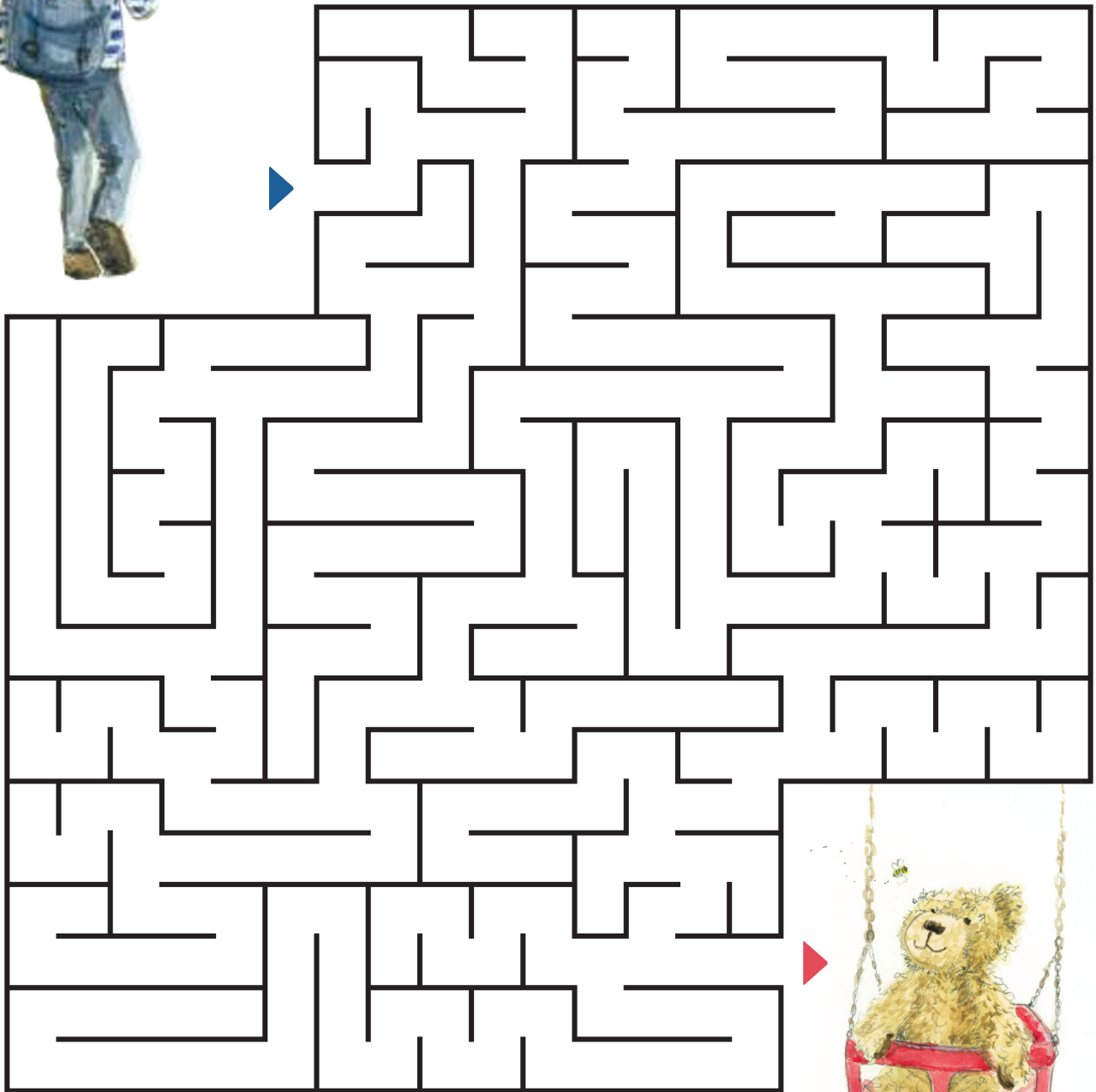

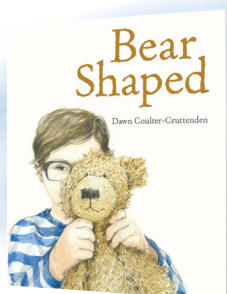
Teddy Bear Maze
