Reading Levels Explained The Bear Can Read suggests a starting reading level for each child based on your child's school stage and the time in the school year (as we mirror schools with our phonics and reading progression). The chart below shows the progression that most children follow in school. However, many children progress at a different pace so you can select a higher or lower starting reading level if you wish. If you know the book band level your child is reading at school, we would recommend that you start your child on the same one. You can easily find the book band level by looking on the back of one of the colour band books they bring home.
