Our handmade flute mats, featured in our Damask Series collection, are entirely handmade from 100% cotton fabric, batting, and thread. (See front page of our Vignette flute mat)

## Cleaning Cloths

The original design by sempre|flute, our multi-use cleaning cloths can be used as either an internal or external cloth. It is entirely up to you!

They are extremely durable and can be washed and ironed as needed.

The fabric tag is meant to lay atop your lap for discreetness for performance purposes—that way there are no visible branding to be shown.

Our Artist Series features solid, classic colors ranging from undyed cotton to jet black. The Practice Series features all of the elegant and eccentric patterns that would brighten any performance or practice session.

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## Care Instructions

### Cleaning Cloths

Machine washable and dryable. Iron as needed for a "just out of the packaging" appearance and feel.

### Flute Mats & Tarnish Savers

It is highly advised that you DO NOT wash your flute mat. If necessary, spot clean with a gentle detergent—no bleach.

DO NOT wash your Tarnish Saver. It will remove the properties from the treated cotton, leaving you a Tarnish Saver that will no longer prevent tarnish.
