WADDESDON ROTHSCHILD COLLECTION

This beautifully bright red Pinot Noir is perfectly balanced. With notes of wild strawberries, menthol and smokey sensations. The finish is aromatic with long, fine tannins.

Cabernet Sauvignon (Pays d'Oc)6 x 75cl

This aromatic wine displays beautiful harmony between the oak notes (clove, toasted bread, smoke) and the fruitiness of over matured grapes (bilberry, blackberry). The mouth offers a nice sweetness with soft tannins and the presence of fruits right to the end.

Displaying a gorgeous dark robe with bright red reflections, this Merlot shows spicy notes with eucalyptus and red fruit aromas on the nose. Sweet fruits and mellow tannins on the palate.

Garnet-red colour with purple-blue tint. Dominant flavours are cherry, redcurrant and plum notes. The palate offers a beautiful freshness with a long lasting finish.

Viognier (Pays d'Oc)......6 x 75cl

The colour is a clear and pale yellow straw. The aromas evoke intense floral notes, citrus peel, vanilla, tangerine and light honey tones. The palate is fresh, pleasant and deliciously well balanced. The finish is rich and persistent.

Chardonnay (Pays d'Oc)......6 x 75cl

Very aromatic nose with notes of quince, honey and spices combined with fresher notes of citrus fruits. The mouth is fleshy and fresh with aromas of white pulp combining to bring notes of mango and ginger. A lingering, fresh finish.

Sauvignon Blanc (Pays d'Oc)......6 x 75cl

Pale yellow colour with green tints. This Sauvignon Blanc expresses fresh and complex notes of asparagus, gun flint and citrus fruits. Crisp and elegant to the end.

Piquepoul (Côtes de Thau IGP)6 x 75cl

Sourced from one of the coolest vineyards of the region, on the border of the Étang de Thau, this Piquepoul has enticing aromas of white flowers with intense, refreshing citrus fruits and a fine, elegant finish.

Rosé (Pays d'Oc)6 x 75cl

Pale colour with ruby tints. Elegant nose of wild blackcurrant and blueberries complemented by notes of spices and pepper, menthol and eucalyptus. Round and soft on the palate with a perfect balance between the rich fruit aromas and a fresh acidity which gives a long-lasting finish..





AT THE HEART OF THE DOMAINES BARONS DE ROTHSCHILD LAFITE GROUP LIES THE ILLUSTRIOUS CHÂTEAU LAFITE ROTHSCHILD. THE FIRST CHÂTEAU PURCHASED BY THE FRENCH ARM OF THE ROTHSCHILD FAMILY, LAFITE HAS CULTIVATED A TRADITION OF WINEGROWING PRACTICES AND EXPERTISE OVER SIX GENERATIONS. NAMED THE 'LAFITE SPIRIT', THIS HAS CONTINUED TO GUIDE THE PRODUCTION OF HIGH QUALITY WINES WITH FINESSE AND ELEGANCE THROUGHOUT THE GROUP'S PROPERTIES OVER THE PAST CENTURY AND A HALF.

It is this pioneering 'Lafite Spirit', based on a rich past and tradition rooted in the soils of Bordeaux, that has led the Group to open up to the world, establishing vineyards in new regions and producing new, high quality wines. The handing down of knowledge from generation to generation persists to the present day, with the most recent succession occurring in 2018 when Saskia de Rothschild became the 6th generation to take up the reins of Château Lafite and Domaines Barons de Rothschild Lafite.

Beyond the Bordeaux properties of Château Duhart-Milon, Château Rieussec and Château L'Évangile, the Group today also counts the prestigious wineries of Viña Los Vascos (Chile, 1988), Domaine d'Aussières (Languedoc, 1999), Bodegas Caro (Argentina, 1999) and a new vineyard in China, Domaine de Long Dai, among its collection. With a total 1,200 hectares of vineyards, Domaines Barons de Rothschild Lafite works with an international network of more than 80 distributors.



LES LÉGENDES

OWNER OF CHÂTEAU LAFITE ROTHSCHILD FOR FIVE GENERATIONS, THE ROTHSCHILD FAMILY HAS BEEN ASSOCIATED WITH THE VINEYARDS OF BORDEAUX SINCE 1868 AND TODAY OWNS CHÂTEAUX LAFITE ROTHSCHILD, DUHART MILON, L'ÉVANGILE AND RIEUSSEC.

In addition to the wines produced from their prestigious vineyards, the Barons de Rothschild have for many years created a range of more accessible wines for everyday drinking. Initially created at the request of family and friends, these were known as the "Réserves des Barons". In a continuation of this tradition, Domaines Barons de Rothschild Lafite decided to produce the Réserves in four major Bordeaux appellations: Bordeaux, Bordeaux Blanc, Médoc and Pauillac. In creating the Collection, DBR Lafite's objective is to offer classic Bordeaux wines with immediate charm.

A major appellation in the Médoc, Pauillac benefits from an exceptional terroir characterized by gravelly hilltops on a clay subsoil which ensures natural drainage and encourages the vines to develop deep roots: these are the perfect conditions for Cabernet Sauvignon.

ANSEILLAN



ANSEILLAN IS NOT A NEW WINE FROM THE DOMAINES BARONS DE ROTHSCHILD LAFITE STABLE. ANSEILLAN HAS ALWAYS BEEN AN INTEGRAL PART OF LAFITE YET IS A COMPLETELY SEPARATE WINE IN ITS OWN RIGHT. NOT A CHÂTEAU, ANSEILLAN IS A WINE, NAMED FOR A 'LIEU-DIT' - A NAMED LOCALITY - WITHIN THE CHÂTEAU LAFITE ROTHSCHILD ESTATE, AND WAS FIRST RELEASED IN 2021 WITH THE 2018 VINTAGE.

The village of Anseillan lies to the east of Lafite Rothschild, between the Château and the Gironde. This area presents a wide variety of terroirs which are the subject of much thought and research. Anseillan is a blend of meticulously selected vineyard plots, born of many years of intense scrutiny, research, and trials at the hands of Château Lafite's technical teams. Located at the very heart of the hamlet, they have been defined precisely within the AOC Pauillac. Cooler and later because of their northern exposure, they are also more clayey than Lafite's classic terroirs. This terroir and the teams' work give Anseillan's wine a unique style and excellent complexity.

Anseillan Pauillac6 x 75cl

Petit Verdot.

A blend of Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon, and Petit Verdot is aged for 16 – 18 months in barrel resulting in great balance, freshness, structure, and length. Expressive notes of cherries with smokey notes from the barrel ageing and a lovely spice from the



MOULIN DE DUHART



IT WAS AT THE URGING OF CHÂTEAU LAFITE'S OWNERS
IN THE EARLY 18TH CENTURY THAT WIDESPREAD GRAPE
CULTIVATION IN THE PAUILLAC DISTRICT BEGAN. JUST
NEXT DOOR, THE PRESTIGIOUS FOURTH GROWTH OF
CHÂTEAU DUHART MILON BECAME LAFITE'S SECOND
PAUILLAC PROPERTY.

The Château's soils have long been recognised for their high quality and its wine was ranked as a Fourth Growth in Pauillac in 1855. However, successive changes in ownership led the estate's vineyards to decline dramatically, and it was only four decades after the Rothschild family acquired it in 1962 that the property saw its prestigious classification restored.

Moulin de Duhart is the second wine of the stunning Duhart-Milon estate, which lies just to the west of Château Lafite's Carruades vineyards. The same technical team, first class facilities and attention to detail are employed in the production of this wine as they are to the first wine of the estate.



BLASON DE L'ÉVANGILE



THROUGH A MYSTERY OF GEOLOGY, THE SOUTHEAST POMEROL PLATEAU FEATURES A LONG LINE OF SURFACE GRAVEL. THREE VINEYARDS, INCLUDING CHÂTEAU L'ÉVANGILE, SHARE THIS RARE SOIL.

The property is bordered to the north by Château Pétrus and separated from Château Cheval Blanc in Saint-Émilion to the south by nothing more than a secondary road.

The vineyard covers 22 hectares, made up of sandy clay soil with pure gravel, on a subsoil containing iron residues. The grape varieties consist of Merlot (80%) which contributes to the wine's fruity flavour, body and its unmistakable suppleness; and 'Bouchet', the local name for Cabernet Franc (20%), which brings finesse and structure.

Château L'Évangile was acquired by Domaines Barons de Rothschild in 1990 from the Ducasse family. Blason de L'Évangile, the estate's second wine, has characteristics similar to the Grand vin, but less potential for ageing as it is matured in barrels for a shorter period of time. It should be enjoyed younger than its more robust counterpart.



CHÂTEAU PARADIS CASSEUIL




CHÂTEAU PARADIS CASSEUIL TAKES ITS NAME FROM
TWO SOURCES. CASSEUIL IS THE NAME OF THE DISTRICT,
WHILST PARADIS COMES FROM THE LAND REGISTRY
WHERE THE MAIN PARCEL OF VINES ON THE PROPERTY
IS KNOWN AS "LES VIGNES DU PARADIS" – THE VINES
OF PARADISE.

Château Paradis Casseuil formerly belonged to Château Rieussec. When purchasing the First Growth of Sauternes in 1984, Baron Eric de Rothschild lost no time in adding this jewel of the Entre-Deux-Mers region to the DBR portfolio. The vineyard of Paradis Casseuil was extended in 1989, becoming one of the leading properties of the region.

Château Paradis Casseuil........... 6 x 75cl A modern and fresh blend of Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon with a little oak and an easy drinking Bordeaux style.



CHÂTEAU ODILON




PREVIOUSLY NAMED CHÂTEAU PEYRE-LEBADE BASED
ON ITS GEOGRAPHICAL LOCATION, THE ESTATE WAS
RENAMED CHÂTEAU ODILON, IN HONOUR OF PAINTER
ODILON REDON WHO SPENT HIS CHILDHOOD AND MOST
OF HIS WORKING LIFE ON THE PROPERTY. HIS MOST
FAMOUS PAINTINGS WERE INSPIRED BY THE BUCOLIC
LANDSCAPES OF THE MÉDOC, SCATTERED WITH MOOR
AND MARSHLANDS.

In 1979, after being neglected for several years, the property was acquired by Baron Edmond de Rothschild who already owned the neighbouring estates: Châteaux Clarke and Malmaison. This acquisition marked the beginning of a new era, starting with the complete restructuring of the vineyards and restoration of the buildings.

The 55 hectares of the estate are planted with Cabernet Sauvignon (24%), Merlot (64%), and Cabernet Franc (12%). The limestone-rich geology of the site certainly influenced the original name of the property, since Peyre-Lebade means 'raised rock' (pierre levée).



R DE RIEUSSEC



THE FIRST GROWTH SAUTERNES PROPERTY OF
CHÂTEAU RIEUSSEC WAS ACQUIRED BY DOMAINES
BARONS DE ROTHSCHILD LAFITE IN 1984. THE ESTATE
THEN CONSISTED OF 110 HECTARES, 68 HECTARES OF
WHICH WERE VINES. TO ENHANCE CHÂTEAU RIEUSSEC'S
POTENTIAL, RIGOROUS MEASURES WERE IMPLEMENTED,
INCLUDING METICULOUS SORTING OF THE GRAPES AND
FERMENTING IN BARRELS, WHICH PROVIDED A MUCH
FINER SELECTION FOR THE BLENDING OF THE GRAND VIN.

Today, Château Rieussec's vineyard extends to the border of Fargues and Sauternes and adjoins Château d'Yquem. Rieussec is one of the largest properties in Sauternes and Barsac, with the vineyard covering 93 hectares of gravelly sandy-clay soil.

In addition to the iconic botrytis wines produced at Rieussec, a dry expression of the grapes is produced. R de Rieussec brings the same Sauvignon and Sémillon blend together but with a vibrant dry style suited to every occasion. Partly produced from the same vines as the Sauternes, 20% of fermentation takes place in barrels which enhances the wine's potential to age, while preserving its freshness and the natural fruitiness from the grapes.



DOMAINE D'AUSSIÈRES

AUSSIÈRES HAS MADE WINE SINCE THE ROMAN ERA, A PERIOD WHEN THE GREAT PROPERTIES OF THE "ROMAN PROVINCE OF NARBONNE" WERE RECORDED IN THE LAND REGISTRY AND BECAME THE MAIN WINE SUPPLIERS TO ROME.

Acquired in 1999 by Domaines Barons de Rothschild Lafite, the 550-hectare Domaine d'Aussières underwent a vast rehabilitation programme to restore and revitalize one of the oldest and most beautiful wine-making properties in the Narbonne region.

167 hectares of vines were replanted with carefully selected traditional Languedoc grape varieties: Syrah, Grenache, Mourvèdre and Carignan, complemented by Cabernet, Merlot and Chardonnay. The estate buildings were restored at the same time and a new winery installed in the old cellars, in the heart of the vineyard.

Two thirds of the vineyard fall in the Corbières AOC appellation and one third in the Vin de Pays d'Oc appellation. The consistency and remarkable potential of the wines produced since 2003 have already positioned Aussières as one of the front runners in the revival of the Languedoc.



DOMAINE D'AUSSIÈRES

Château d'Aussières (Corbières) 6 x 75cl OWC

The rich, full bodied first wine of the estate; Syrah, Grenache, Mourvèdre and old vine Carignan with 18 months ageing in oak. Presented individually wrapped in laying wooden 6 pack cases.

Altan d'Aussières (Corbières)......6 x 75cl

A blend of Syrah, Grenache Noir and Carignan results in a beautiful concentration of fruit and aromas. This wine is generous and full-bodied, offering a complex palette of flavours from deep within the identity of our terroir.

Château d'Aussières Rosé (Corbières)......6 x 75cl

(Magnums 15ocl and Double Magnums 3oocl also available)
Rich aromatic palate of summer fruit laced with aromas of sour
candy. Round and powerful, this blend of Syrah and Grenache
Noir presents a great balance layered with notes of toasted
almonds and hazelnuts.

Blason d'Aussières (Corbières)6 x 75cl

Deep, smooth and rounded, this is the second wine of the estate; Syrah, Grenache, Mourvèdre and old vine Carignan are blended with 12 months of oak ageing.

Aussières Rouge (Pays d'Oc).....6 x 75cl

An approachable and fresh Pays d'Oc rouge, perfect for house pour and weddings.

Aussières Blanc (Pays d'Oc)6 x 75cl

A light and fresh Pays d'Oc Chardonnay, perfect for house pour and weddings.

Aussières Rosé (Pays d'Oc)6 x 75cl

A crisp, refreshing and fruity rosé. A delightful blend of Cinsault, Grenache, Cabernet Franc and Syrah.



VIÑA LOS VASCOS

"30 YEARS AGO, I VISITED LOS VASCOS FOR THE FIRST TIME AND WAS IMMEDIATELY IN AWE AT THE BEAUTY AND SIZE OF THE ESTATE WE HAD HERE. SINCE THEN, I'VE COME BACK EVERY YEAR AND THE MAGIC HAS BEEN SEEING THIS LAND EVOLVE THROUGH THE WORK OF NATURE AND OF OUR TEAMS. IT HAS GROWN TO BECOME AN ESTATE WITH ITS OWN UNIQUE ECOSYSTEM OF BIRDS, TREES AND MOST IMPORTANTLY EXCEPTIONAL PEOPLE AND VINEYARDS" - BARON ERIC DE ROTHSCHILD

Domaines Barons De Rothschild Lafite took over Los Vascos (meaning the Basques, in honour of its Basque origins) in 1988. At the time, the estate extended to 2,200 hectares with 220 hectares planted to vine.

Planted in a single block, the vineyard at Viña Los Vascos benefits from intense exposure to the sun, adequate water sources, semiarid soils and little risk of frost. This unique microclimate has everything needed to produce extraordinary wines and a mixture of grape varietals thrive here: Cabernet Sauvignon (85%), Carmenère (5%), Syrah (4%), Malbec (1%) and Chardonnay (5%).

Following a major replanting at the beginning of the 1990s, the vineyard is divided between a group of 15-year old plots and another group of 40 to 50-year old plots. The oldest vines are 70 years old.



VIÑA LOS VASCOS

Le Dix de Los Vascos......6 x 75cl

The first wine of the estate, a velvety blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Carménère & Syrah sourced from only the best plots, with 18 months of oak ageing. Presented individually wrapped in laying wooden 6 pack cases.

Los Vascos Cromas Syrah Gran Reserva 12 x 75cl

Packed with layers of red fruits; fresh plums and figs, and spices; black pepper and anise with subtle oak aromas over a backdrop of graphite, tobacco, and cedar. A wine that takes you on a journey through the slopes of the Los Vascos estate.

Los Vascos Cromas Cabernet

Franc Gran Reserva 12 x 75cl

Bright ruby red in colour with a strawberry and blackberry-dominated nose that gradually reveals notes of gooseberries, black cherries, herbs, and roasted red peppers. Barrel-aging enhances the complexity of aromas and adds notes of tiramisu and dried fruits.

Los Vascos Cromas Gran Reserva...... 12 x 75cl

The Cromas range is inspired by the colours of the estate. The Gran Reserva is inspired by the vibrant autumn shades that dress the estate during late harvesting. A Cabernet Sauvignon blend with 12 months of oak aging. Dark berry fruits with black pepper and toasted walnuts.

Los Vascos Cromas

The beautifully relaunched Los Vascos Grande Reserve, Cromas Carménère Gran Reserva now reflects the unique red hues of the Andes mountains and the ultramarine ocean breathing life into the vineyards.

Los Vascos Cromas Chardonnay Gran Reserva....... 12 x 75cl

A vibrant and concentrated Chardonnay with a nice creamy mouthfeel leading to an elegant finish. Partially fermented in stainless steel tanks to retain freshness and partially fermented in oak barrels providing volume and complexity.

Los Vascos Cabernet Sauvignon..... 12 x 75cl

A fresh and varietally honest Cabernet Sauvignon. Blackcurrant and cassis flavours with a light profile for everyday drinking.

Los Vascos Chardonnay...... 12 x 75cl

A light, unoaked Chardonnay with tropical fruit and citrus notes. Lees aging provides great length and a smooth and rounded mouthfeel.

A bright and vibrant Sauvignon Blanc with perfect acidity. Gooseberry, lychee and peach notes are complemented with asparagus tips and freshly mown lawns.

Los Vascos Rosé......12 x 75cl

A light and elegant rosé blend, with strawberry, peach and nectarine notes. Ideal summer drinking.



BODEGAS CARO

THE IDEA OF FORMING A PARTNERSHIP BETWEEN DOMAINES BARONS DE ROTHSCHILD LAFITE AND THE PRESTIGIOUS ARGENTINIAN WINE FAMILY CATENA WAS BORN IN 1999. INITIAL ENTHUSIASM QUICKLY BECAME A CONCRETE PLAN TO PRODUCE A SINGLE WINE THAT WOULD COMBINE FRENCH AND ARGENTINE CULTURES AND ENHANCE THE ALLIANCE BETWEEN THE SIGNATURE GRAPE OF EACH PRODUCER, MALBEC AND CABERNET SAUVIGNON.

Work began in 1999 to produce Bodegas CARO's first vintage in 2000. The success of the early vintages resulted in the creation of another wine in 2003, AMANCAYA, which similarly to its older brother is based on a harmonious balance of Argentinian identity and Bordeaux style. Bodegas CARO later decided to celebrate the grape variety for which Argentina's vineyards are famous by launching a pure Malbec, ARUMA, in 2010.

The most recent addition to the esteemed portfolio has been Petit Caro. Working with a similar blend to Amancaya, sourced from only the best plots and given extra time in oak for a beautiful smokey depth of flavour.

The Bodegas CARO winery, set in the heart of Mendoza, has been producing the wines since the 2003 vintage and serves as the anchor of the CARO project. The renovation of the historic building and gardens in order to expand the winery and open the Bodega to the outside has brought the final touch to the original project.



BODEGAS CARO

Caro6 x 75cl

The iconic and collectable first wine of the estate. Malbec and Cabernet Sauvignon sourced from the oldest vines and aged in oak for 18 months. Presented individually wrapped in laying wooden 6 pack cases.

With all the elegance and power of its big brother, Petit Caro offers the signature blend of Malbec and Cabernet Sauvignon with more than 12 months in Lafite's French oak barrels.

Ever popular and now a globally iconic brand in itself. Malbec and Cabernet Sauvignon blend with 12 months of oak ageing. White pepper and smokey notes complement the dark fruit flavours.

A fresh and vibrant Malbec presented with no oak age and bright dark and red berry fruit flavours. An unmistakable French elegance ensures Aruma stands out from other Malbecs at this price point.









JAMES DE ROTHSCHILD'S GREAT-GRANDSON, EDMOND DE ROTHSCHILD, BEGAN A NEW CHAPTER IN THE FAMILY WINEGROWING ADVENTURE IN 1973 BY ACQUIRING TWO CRUS BOURGEOIS ESTATES IN THE LISTRAC AND MOULIS-EN-MÉDOC APPELLATIONS OF BORDEAUX: CHÂTEAU CLARKE AND CHÂTEAU MALMAISON.

And so The Compagnie Vinicole Baron Edmond de Rothschild was born. In 1997, Benjamin and Ariane de Rothschild gave a dramatic boost to the Compagnie Vinicole by exploring new terroirs around the globe. Determined to apply traditional French expertise while maintaining local winegrowing practices, they created joint-ventures with families that possessed the same entrepreneurial spirit and love of wine, first in South Africa, then in Argentina and finally New Zealand. Vines planted around the world in virgin lands are now the source of internationally renowned, high quality wines.





ELEGANT, FINE, AND DENSE, EMBODYING THE TYPICAL CHARACTER OF ITS TERROIR, CHÂTEAU CLARKE IS CONSIDERED ONE OF THE MOST PROMISING WINES IN THE MÉDOC. TODAY'S FOCUS ON EXCELLENCE AIMS TO BRING OUT ITS FULL POTENTIAL, BOTH IN THE VINEYARD AND IN THE CELLAR, AND TO ELEVATE CHÂTEAU CLARKE TO RANK AMONG THE GREATEST MÉDOC WINES.

The estate is in the southern part of the Médoc within the Listrac-Médoc appellation. Its inland location is far from the Gironde estuary in the middle of the limestone plateau and a distinctive feature of the estate's clay-limestone soil is its remarkable drought resistance.

The proximity of the Atlantic Ocean gives a cool freshness that is echoed in the wine's bright bouquet. Though Cabernet Sauvignon is traditionally king of the region, the Château's terroir is very well suited to growing Merlot and this varietal accounts for 70% of the estate's production. Thus, Château Clarke is typical of the Médoc, but in an entirely original way.

Sauvignon Blanc, Sauvignon Gris, Muscadelle and Sémillon, which are used in the Le Merle Blanc blend, occupy a small, three-hectare space for limited production.

This property, which adjoins Château Clarke, was purchased by Baron de Rothschild in 1973. Thanks to his impetus, the vineyard was restored to its former glory. He named the wine after his spouse, the Baroness Nadine de Rothschild, a passionate gardener. The vineyard now covers 33 hectares of clay-limestone soil, which is ideal for Merlot, the predominant grape variety. Château Malmaison allies delicacy, suppleness and elegance with a rich and fruity bouquet.



JUST A GRAPE'S THROW FROM CHÂTEAU DES LAURETS, THE CHÂTEAU DE MALENGIN VINEYARD NESTLES IN THE AMPHITHEATRE OF A VALLEY FLOWED THROUGH BY THE BARBANNE. PERCHED ON A SHEER LIMESTONE HEADLAND, A SENTINEL OF STONE WATCHES OVER ITS VINES. MONTAGNE SAINT-ÉMILION IS ONE OF THE SO-CALLED "SATELLITE" APPELLATIONS WHICH ABUTS THE AOC SAINT-ÉMILION TO THE NORTHEAST AND EXTENDS ITS LIMESTONE PLATEAU.

Its vineyards benefits from the same clay-limestone soils.

The estate, encompasses 11.5 hectares of this land and is continuing to explore its terroir and its potential by announcing new creative ambitions. With its new cuvée EVE, Château de Malengin is breaking free from Bordeaux codes to reveal another side to its personality and begin its stylistic revolution.

The vineyards surrounding the Château and the estate's slope receive optimal southern exposure. The clay-limestone terroir is naturally ideal for growing Merlot, the reigning grape of Saint-Émilion, for this soil profile enables the variety to achieve its full power and signature qualities. Black grape varieties are grown on all the plots.

Of the 95 hectares that make up the property, 36 hectares are reserved to produce Château des Laurets, a blend that is primarily Merlot complemented by Cabernet Franc.

Another four hectares were chosen from the best Merlot plots to produce a wine that epitomizes the property. Ever since his purchase of Château des Laurets, Benjamin de Rothschild wished to reveal the quintessence of this estate by making a special cuvée, and so, Château des Laurets Baron was created. This wine remained a family secret until 2015, when it was revealed for the very first time.



"I wanted to create a rosé for a long time, and Amistà was born out of my collaboration with Valérie Rousselle, a friend with whom I share the same values of authenticity and joie de vivre," explains Ariane de Rothschild. Amistà is created using fruit selected exclusively from a Grand Cru Classé vineyard and only the very finest plots are harvested.

"We discovered a wonderful terroir in a single plot, with an ideal exposure and a gradient that favours natural drainage. The clay-limestone soils are reminiscent of the Bordeaux region. The diversity of the grape varieties contributes to the complexity. It is a wonder to see so much freshness born from a sun-drenched earth. In this blend, we have sought to emphasize this balance, this crisp freshness that for us is the signature of Grands Crus." Fabrice Bandiera, winemaker for Edmond de Rothschild Heritage.

THE NAME OF THE PROPERTY WAS A DELIBERATE CHOICE: IT MEANS "FIVE ARROWS" IN MAORI AND SIMULTANEOUSLY HONOURS THE ROTHSCHILD FAMILY'S EMBLEM AND TRADITIONAL NEW ZEALAND CULTURE.

Rimapere enjoys an incredible terroir. The vineyard comprises 24 hectares of vines that are ideally situated on the prestigious Rapaura site, known as the 'Golden Triangle', where the alluvial soil comprises mainly pebbles and gravel. Sauvignon Blanc is grown on 20 hectares and 4 hectares are kept aside for the cultivation of Pinot Noir.

The vineyard is sustainably farmed, with an average age of around 15 years. This area's cool climate is perfect for ripening high quality Sauvignon Blanc grapes and providing them with their typical lemon and grapefruit flavours, together with crisp acidity.

FLECHAS DE LOS ANDES IS THE RESULT OF AN ALLIANCE BETWEEN BARON BENJAMIN DE ROTHSCHILD AND MONSIEUR LAURENT DASSAULT, REFLECTING THE FULFILMENT OF THEIR QUEST TO FIND A GREAT TERROIR AT THE BASE OF THE ANDES. LOCATED 120 KILOMETRES SOUTH OF MENDOZA, ARGENTINA, NEAR THE VILLAGE OF VISTA FLORES, THE FLECHAS DE LOS ANDES VINEYARD NOW OCCUPIES MORE THAN 100 HECTARES IN THE ANDES FOOTHILLS. THE FIRST VINES WERE PLANTED IN 1999 AND ARE QUITE DENSE FOR ARGENTINA (5,500 VINES PER HECTARE).

The Malbec grapes thrive on these ideal plots of rocks, granite pebbles and alluvial gravels perched at 1,100 meters above sea level.

They are joined by plots of Merlot, Syrah and Cabernet Sauvignon.

The hot, dry climate is characterized as semiarid continental and features pronounced temperature fluctuations between day and night and across seasons. These mid-altitude conditions are highly conducive to the ripening of black grapes and, more particularly, of Malbec.



The Rupert & Rothschild wine-growing region sits amongst the northernmost vineyards of the southern hemisphere, and the vines they cultivate here extend over more than 100 hectares. The partnership's estate in Fredericksburg, an historic French Huguenot farm established in 1690, lies at the foot of the spectacular Simonsberg mountain in the Franschhoek Valley between Stellenbosch, Paarl and Franschhoek.

The deal struck between Dr Anton Rupert and Baron Edmond de Rothschild in 1997 has continued to be passed down the generations, with both men relinquishing the reigns to their respective sons: Anthonij Rupert and Baron Benjamin de Rothschild. Following the passing of Anthonij Rupert in 2001, his older brother Johann Rupert and sister Hanneli Rupert-Koegelenberg assumed his position.

Rupert & Rothschild produce three distinct wines; a single varietal Chardonnay; Rupert & Rothschild Baroness Nadine, named after the wife of Baron Edmond; a flagship Bordeaux blend; Rupert & Rothschild Baron Edmond and a classic red blend; Rupert & Rothschild Classique, one of South Africa's most sought after red blends.

Today, Rupert & Rothschild Vignerons is an internationally recognised premier wine brand. A luxuriously elegant and classical brand that underpins a winemaking philosophy of excellence and craftsmanship.



BARON EDMOND DE ROTHSCHILD

RUPERT & ROTHSCHILD


WHEN BARON NATHANIEL ACQUIRED CHÂTEAU MOUTON ROTHSCHILD AT AUCTION IN 1853, LITTLE DID HE KNOW THAT HE HELD IN HIS HANDS THE KEYS TO THE START OF ONE OF THE WORLD'S MOST RESPECTED BORDEAUX WINE BRANDS

Founded 80 years later in 1933, the Baron Philippe de Rothschild Group today manages an exquisite roster of estates and branded wines that expand far beyond its Bordeaux heart, maintaining the same dedication to excellence that has characterised the family's winemaking style for generations.

The Group's activities in Bordeaux comprise three Classified Growths in the Pauillac appellation, Château d'Armailhac (1933), Château Clerc Milon (1970) and of course the illustrious Château Mouton Rothschild. In addition they offer a range of high quality branded wines that are sourced from various partner growers and then blended, matured and bottled by the Group itself, foremost among them the famous Mouton Cadet.

Expansions have continued in France to the Pays d'Oc at Domaine de Baronarques (1998), and across the Atlantic with two pioneering family partnerships; one with the Mondavi family and the establishment of Opus One Winery (1979) in the USA and another with Concha y Toro in Chile with the formation of Viña Almaviva (1997), in addition to other branded Chilean wines Escudo Rojo and Mas Andes.

It is a unique blend of respect for traditional know-how and adaptability that have ensured the continued quality and prestige of the Group's wines. To this day it remains an entirely family affair, run by three siblings Camille Sereys de Rothschild, Philippe Sereys de Rothschild and Julien de Beaumarchais de Rothschild.

THIS VENERABLE ESTATE LOCATED NEAR LIMOUX WAS BOUGHT IN 1998 BY BARONESS PHILIPPINE DE ROTHSCHILD AND HER TWO SONS, PHILIPPE SEREYS DE ROTHSCHILD AND JULIEN DE BEAUMARCHAIS DE ROTHSCHILD. THE VINEYARD AND WINEMAKING FACILITIES HAVE SINCE BEEN EXTENSIVELY RENOVATED.

Domaine de Baronarques has 43 hectares (106 acres) of vines with a diversity of soils and micro-climates which give the wines complexity and elegance. The estate is planted with 70% Bordeaux varieties (Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc) and 30% Mediterranean varieties (Syrah, Grenache and Malbec) and a small plot dedicated to Chardonnay.

The estate's identity is fashioned to a great extent by two contrasting climates; Mediterranean, guaranteeing optimum sunshine, and Atlantic, bringing often welcome rain during times of drought. In addition, being not far from the Pyrenees, the grapes grow at an altitude that tempers the summer heat (250 to 350 metres).

The vineyard is tended with scrupulous attention to every detail with the aim of producing the finest red and white wines.

Produced and vinified in the hallowed Bordeaux tradition, the wines from Domaine de Baronarques now set the standard within one of France's oldest wine-growing regions.

THE FOCUS IS ON SOURCING THE BEST WINES AND CREATING A BLEND THAT DEEPLY RESPECTS BOTH THE INDIVIDUAL TERROIRS AND THE VINTAGE, WHICH HAS LED TO A LOYAL BASE OF CLIENTS WHO FOLLOW HIS WINES IN EVERY VINTAGE

Nicolas, being the son of esteemed winemaker Gérard Potel, began his Burgundian education from the youngest possible age, growing up on the family estate at Domaine de la Pousse D'Or, in Volnay before training at Domaine Matrot and Domaine Roumier

All of this led him to build up a network of contacts, alongside a reputation, to source the highest quality grapes and wine from top domaines. He continues to use the same sources and maintains the hands-on relationship with the growers he has worked with for almost 30 years.

The name Bellene comes from the ancient Gallic God of sun and beauty, Belenos. The city of Beaune was originally known as Belena during the Roman period, and from these historic titles Nicolas drew the name Bellene.

Along with an eclectic range of Regional, Village and Premier Cru Burgundies, Maison Roche de Bellene offers the largest selection of Grand Cru wines in Burgundy which are available on request.



ROCHE DE BELLENE

Rully Blanc Villages 6 x 75cl

The village of Rully is located in the Côte Chalonnaise. This wine comes from vines between 45 and 50 years old grown on a clay and limestone soil at an average altitude of 225m. Light and perfumed with notes of honeysuckle, lemon, lime and white peaches.

Saint-Aubin 1er Cru La Chatenière 6 x 75c

La Chatenière is located in the South-West block of the Saint-Aubin 1er Crus next to En Remilly, Les Murgers des Dents de Chien, and Sur Gamay closest to Puligny-Montrachet and Chassagne-Montrachet. This is opulent for a Saint-Aubin with deep notes of honey, white flowers and peaches.

Bourgogne Côte D'Or Pinot Noir 6 x 75cl

This wine has a floral perfume complimented by red cherries, strawberries and blackcurrant. Well-rounded with fine, silk like tannins.

Beaune 1er Cru 6 x 75cl

A combination of three vineyards to produce a more complex and layered wine. Each vineyard contributes different characteristics to give a wine that shows the overall diverse terroir of the village. Aromas of both red and black fruit with fine tannins and excellent structure.

Santenay 1er Cru La Comme 6 x 75cl

Santenay is at the Southern end of the Côte de Beaune although the geological strata is similar to that of the Côte de Nuits. La Comme is at the Chassange-Montrachet end of Santenay touching the premier cru vineyards of Beauregard, Clos Tavannes and Les Gravières. This wine is made from 45 year old vines that are South-West facing planted on clay and limestone soil. Deep notes of violet and red fruits. Complex and well rounded.

Nuits-Saint-Georges Vieilles Vignes 6 x 75cl

The age of the vines are between 45 and 54 years old and are East facing at an altitude of 270m. Aged in 20% new French oak, this wine is dominated by red fruit with notes of cherry, strawberry and blackcurrant. Well balanced with the bold structure balanced by acidity.





ROCHE DE BELLENE

Meursault 1er Cru Les Ravelles 6 x 75cl

One of the lesser known Meursault 1er Crus and also one of the highest positioned. Aged in 50% new French oak, this wine is pale green gold, notes of white peaches and honey alongside butter and a minerality. Well-rounded, balanced and rich.

Puligny-Montrachet 1er Cru La Garenne 6 x 75cl

High up the slope in Puligny-Montrachet next to hamlet of Blagny. An East facing vineyard with very light soil La Garenne produces wines with an emphasis on finesse. The vines here are 45 years old. Bright gold colour, with notes of green apple, white flower and peaches. Very complex with a core acidity and a very long finish.

Gevrey-Chambertin Cuvée Reserve 6 x 75cl

This is a Classic Gevrey-Chambertin with a crisp mixture of red and black fruits. Prominent notes of crunchy blackcurrants with redcurrant, sweet fruit balanced with fresh acidity with a mouthwatering finish

Gevrey-Chambertin 1er Cru Champeaux 6 x 75cl

Located on the mid-slope; the vineyard of Champeaux is positioned on the most Northern side of the Gevrey-Chambertin 1er Crus. Fruit driven; showing the classic blackcurrant and redcurrant with a core structure and rich round tannins.

Chambolle-Musigny 1er Cru Les Fuées 6 x 75cl

Located right next to the Grand Cru vineyard of Bonnes Mares and sharing a very similar underlying rock formation. This wine has notes of violet, raspberry and strawberry. Silky smooth tannins with an elegance that shows the true character of Chambolle-Musigny.

LOCATED NEXT TO THE HOME OF FRANCOIS PERRIN, NEAR TO CHÂTEAU DE BEAUCASTEL, LE GRAND PREBOIS IS THE NAME OF THE PROPERTY HOUSING THE STATE OF THE ART FAMILLE PERRIN WINERY. ALL OF THE WINES FROM THE FAMILIES VINEYARD HOLDINGS IN THE SOUTHERN RHONE ARE PRODUCED AND MATURED HERE.

Le Grand Prebois is a select range of wines that explore the richness and different terroirs of the Southern Rhône. Practicing the same skills, with the same passion as for Château de Beaucastel, the Perrin Family explore the spirit of each terroir, its authenticity and its unique specificity; encapsulating within each of these wines their expertise and signature - the art of blending and the fresh flavours of the South.

LE GRAND PREBOIS

Côtes du Rhône Blanc12 x 75cl

Characteristic of Viognier and its floral notes, this is a wine with an incredible freshness and great depth. It will be a wonderful match for Mediterranean dishes and fish.

Côtes du Rhône Rouge...... 12 x 75cl

Classic Côtes du Rhône, fruit and fresh with beautiful tannins, it's a great everyday wine made almost exclusively from the Grand Prébois vineyards and Vinsobres vineyards.

Vacqueyras12 x 75cl

Cultivated on clay and stony soils, the Grenache that forms the heart of this wine develops power and depth. Its characteristic aromas of chocolate, cherry and fig marry perfectly with those of the Syrah.

Gigondas6 x 75cl

Grown on the sandy soil of sedimentary safres which make up a small part of the appellation, this Grenache shows immense suppleness, aromatic expression and balance.

Châteauneuf-du-Pape6 x 75cl

This elegant wine is made mainly from Grenache and can be enjoyed immediately. A beautiful garnet red with shiny reflections, aromatic with notes of leather and a long finish.



CHÂTEAU LÉOUBE

NESTLED IN A COASTAL BAY IN PROVENCE, JUST A STONE'S THROW FROM ST. TROPEZ, LIES THE LÉOUBE ESTATE, ONE OF THE MOST BEAUTIFUL PROTECTED SITES IN EUROPE AND HOME TO CHÂTEAU LÉOUBE.

Spread across four kilometres of coastline, the estate includes 65 hectares of vineyards and 20 hectares of olive groves, all devoted to growing the grapes and olives that make Léoube's certified organic wines and olive oils

Provence is home to some of the oldest vineyards in France, with soils dating back over 800 million years. To maintain the heritage of the land, Château Léoube believes in time-honoured, artisan farming, following biodynamic principles. Guided by head wine maker Romain Ott, this is what they have strived to make reality.

All grapes are harvested and sorted by hand, in tune with the seasonal and lunar cycles. It is believed that if the balance of the plant is respected, then it will produce only the most balanced fruit in return. The flourishing of the vines and olive trees at Léoube bear testimony to the wisdom of this natural approach.

In the cellar, only whole clusters of grapes are used and crushed by direct pressing. The wines are fermented with indigenous yeasts and also undergo malolactic fermentation, with little-to-no use of sulphites.

The Château's rosés undergo at least six months on the lees, to allow complex flavours and textures to develop and resulting in wines that are well balanced, fresh, and full of character, whilst remaining true to their terroir.

Love by Léoube......6 x 75cl

A harmonious blend of Grenache and Cinsault, Love is a quintessential, dry Provence rosé style. Pale Pink with attractive fruit flavours of strawberry and white peach and fine overall balance.

Rosé de Léoube6 x 75cl

A blend of Grenache, Cinsault, Syrah and Mourvèdre, this is definitely a wine of elegance over power. Delicate notes of honey, mint and soft red fruits with a perfectly balanced acidity and long finish.

Le Secret de Léoube6 x 75cl

Made from lower yields, Secret is delicately scented, distinctly pale and carries the most elegant of pear aromas. Assured and effortless, Secret is remarkable for its texture and sensation in the mouth.

Collector Rosé......6 x 75cl

This is a fascinating wine, clearly rosé in colour and style, and yet with a richer texture and mouthfeel, reminiscent of a white Burgundy. Whilst dry and crisp, there is a fine intensity of strawberry and white peach fruit.

CELENE CRÉMANT DE BORDEAUX

LOCATED IN THE VILLAGE OF HAUX, IN THE HEART OF THE ENTRE-DEUX-MERS REGION, CELENE SPECIALISES IN THE PRODUCTION OF PREMIUM SPARKLING WINES, ESPECIALLY IN AOC CRÉMANT DE BORDEAUX.

The Crémant de Bordeaux AOC was officially established in 1990 and uses typical Bordeaux grape varieties in the traditional method of producing sparkling wines. Grapes are harvested manually and are aged in Celene's cellars which are old underground quarries, dug in the 18th century into the limestone rock of the right bank of the Garonne. The stone extracted from these quarries was transported by ship and has been used to create buildings and monuments in the city of Bordeaux.

Celene's natural cellars ensure a constant temperature of 13°C and provide the ideal conditions and environment for the development of aromas and persistent fine bubble characterised by Crémants.

Celene Cuvée Royale Brut

Crémant de Bordeaux6 x 75cl

Aged for two years in underground cellars, this Crémant is a blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Sémillon, and Muscadelle and is well balanced with a long fruity finish.

Crémant de Bordeaux6 x 75cl

A blend of Cabernet Franc and Merlot, this Rosé Crémant has a persistent and fine bubble and is full of blackcurrant notes and aromas of candied fruit. Fresh, smooth, long, and fruity.

The grapes are harvested by hand, carefully selecting the best bunches to obtain a top quality Cava made using the champenoise method.

Very pale yellow with golden hues, this fruity and fresh cava is beautifully balanced. The Macabeo, Xarello and Parellada all contribute to the white fruit, apple, pear and white flowers on the nose and palate.

BARÓN DO SIL

Bodegas Barón do Sil is located at Petín de Valdeorras, a small Spanish village in the province of Orense, Galicia, belonging to the Valdeorras appellation. It is a family project with its own vineyards and limited productions of high quality wines. The main variety in its vineyards is Godello, but there are also varieties such as Mencía, Garnacha de Altura and Palomino.

Godello 6 x 75cl

Floral, Fresh & Complex. This 100% Godello is from Valdeorras in Galicia, Spain. Lovely minerality is beautifully balanced with floral and fruity elements.





CHAN DE ROSAS

Chan de Rosas produces exceptional Albariño from vineyards in the heart of Rías Baixas in north-west Spain. Their ethos is centred around traditional winemaking methods with a focus on small parcel production which enables the true reflection of the Albariño grape. Purity, definition, and varietal expression sit at the heart of their stylistic approach.



Verve, vitality, and energy with no oak influence. This Albariño from the Salnés Valley is hand-harvested and is brimming with citrus fruit, elderflower, and honeysuckle with a mineral-focused freshness.

Cuvée Especial6 x 75cl

The characterful Cuvée Especial incorporates hand-harvested Albariño with a small proportion (15%) aged in French oak barrels to aid texture, weight, and complexity. Full of citrus peel, green apple, white peach, honeysuckle, and subtle vanilla notes.

Pale yellow with greenish reflections, the nose displays aromas of white flowers, citrus and white fruit. On the palate it is fresh, persistent and unctuous thanks to it's lees aging.



PETIT VEGA

Petit Vega from Ribera del Duero is a personal project by Isaac Fernández Montaño, who is one of the most renowned oenologists in Spain. He has been chief oenologist at several excellent wineries in Ribera del Duero and has gained recognition as a brilliant producer. Petit Vega utilises Tempranillo grown on limestone soils with an elevation of close to goom.





MARQUÉS DE TOMARES

Marqués de Tomares is a family winery, whose beginnings date back to 1910 when "Grandpa D. Román Montaña" began to dedicate himself to the production and aging of wines. Today, it is his grandchildren who continue this work with great success 





Penfolds Bin 28 Shiraz.....6 x 75cl

First made in 1959, Bin 28 was originally named after the famous Barossa Valley Kalimna vineyard purchased by Penfolds in 1945 and from which the wine was originally sourced. Today, Bin 28 is a multi-region, multi-vineyard blend, with the Barossa Valley always well represented.

Penfolds Bin 311 Chardonnay......6 x 75cl

Bin 311 exhibits lemon & lime flavours with a mineral acid backbone. Complemented by barrel-fermentation and maturation in mostly seasoned oak. Minimal filtration is employed, preserving elegant fruit.

Penfolds Bin 51 Riesling......6 x 75cl

First produced in 1999, Bin 51 Riesling is sourced from the elevated vineyards of the Eden Valley. Possessing intense purity of fruit, concentration of flavours, great finesse and capacity for long-term cellaring.

Typically a soft, medium bodied wine, the Bin 2 blend of Shiraz and Mataro is still relatively uncommon. A wonderful, Mediterranean style blend unlike any other wine in the collection.


OXHARDY

OX HARDY IS THE PRECIOUS COMBINATION OF FAMILY, HERITAGE, AND PROVENANCE INSPIRED BY A FATHER AND SON PROJECT WHICH USHERS IN THE NEXT CHAPTER OF A MULTI-GENERATIONAL LEGACY.

The Hardy's are one of the founding families of the Australian wine industry and the Upper Tintara Vineyard is central to their story.

Since Thomas Hardy purchased the land in late 1870s, it has passed from one generation of Hardy to the next, a constant traversing through time. Today, Andrew 'Ox' Hardy and his family look after the 140-hectare farm in Blewitt Springs, on the upper slopes of McLaren Vale. Nestled beside thirty hectares of native bush are 45 hectares of vine; 2.54 hectares of which are the ancestor vines, originally planted by Ox's great-great grandfather in 1891.

Ox's winemaking experience spans four decades. Having worked with some of the greats in Australia and abroad, today he focuses his energy crafting benchmark wines which showcase the terroir of the iconic Upper Tintara Vineyard. With one foot in the past, he honours his heritage with three expressions of estate grown Blewitt Springs Shiraz. With the other foot firmly in the future, he celebrates the versatility of McLaren Vale, embracing emerging varieties that suit the terroir and changing climate, ensuring the legacy continues for his children's children to enjoy.

FROM THE FIRST VINEYARDS BEING PLANTED IN 1891 BY VISIONARY SCOTTISH
PIONEER, JOHN RIDDOCH, WYNNS COONAWARRA ESTATE HAS BUILT A REPUTATION

John Riddoch completed the estate's famous three-gabled winery in 1896. Later in 1951 Melbourne wine merchants Samuel and David Wynn purchased Riddoch's original vineyards and winery and renamed the property Wynns Coonawarra Estate. The Wynns family recognised the intrinsic qualities of Coonawarra wines - their richness and intensity of fruit character - and set out to build an independent identity in the region. They created the famous label that has made John Riddoch's winery one of Australia's best-known buildings and a recognised symbol of heritage and refinement – qualities Wynns prides itself on.



WYNNS COONAWARRA ESTATE

Wynns Coonawarra Estate Chardonnay......6 x 75cl

The long ripening season from Coonawarra's cool southerly climate produces Chardonnay with excellent varietal character. Poached pear and stone fruit balance the soft natural acidity. Underlying complex barrel ferment characters present an elegant, beautifully balanced wine.

Elegant and silky with generous mulberry and blackberry notes.

Delicate oak used to match and support the fine palate structure without dominating its distinctive cool climate character.

HUNDRED ACRE WINE GROUP

HUNDRED ACRE IS THE ULTRA-PREMIUM CULT NAPA CABERNET PROJECT OF JAYSON WOODBRIDGE, OWNER, VINTNER AND VISIONARY. HIS MOTTO IS CONCISE, "STAND AMONGST THE VERY BEST OR NOT AT ALL". AND THAT HE HAS ACHIEVED WITHOUT APOLOGY. AFTER SELLING HIS HOUSE, BUSINESS AND JUST ABOUT EVERYTHING ELSE, HE BOUGHT HIS FIRST VINEYARD IN NAPA VALLEY IN 1998 AND NEVER LOOKED BACK.

Exacting and unrelenting in his passions, for Woodbridge there is no halfway. And it is only once you truly grasp that concept that you begin to understand how Hundred Acre has become one of the world's top wineries. The awarding of 22 perfect 100 scores to Hundred Acre wines by Robert Parker's Wine Advocate since 2002 speaks for itself. As Lisa Perrotti-Brown states, Hundred Acre is "far from a vanity wine project, it's a life's work".

Woodbridge's unique approach sees him intimately involved in each step of the grape-growing and winemaking process, from hand-picking in numerous passes, hand-sorting berry by berry, to carefully selecting the forest and age of barrels used.

Everything is hand-crafted, hand-pruned, scrutinized and aligned for his desired response. Each Cabernet Sauvignon represents three single estate vineyards from Napa Valley, named after Woodbridge's three children: Kayli Morgan, ARK and Few and Far Between.

A plethora of distinct blends and differently-aged lots also make up the Hundred Acre portfolio, such as Wraith, a 'Holy Trinity' blend of Kayli Morgan, ARK and Few and Far Between, and Deep Time, a study in how oak integrates over time and how Cabernet Sauvignon can continue to concentrate over five or more years.



HUNDRED ACRE

Ark Vineyard

ARK is comprised of nine different blocks of Cabernet Sauvignon, planted meter by meter in nine different volcanic soil strata. The vineyard stretches through a sixty-million-year time sequence: three ancient beach fronts, a prehistoric weapons quarry, and spans a 180-degree arc of the sun over its half-mile length.

Ark Deep Time

Hundred Acre Deep Time wines are aged for a minimum of 36 months in the finest French oak barriques. The stave wood is hand-selected for ultra-tight grain, then air dried for three years before being made into barrels.

Kayli Morgan Vineyard

The Kayli Morgan Vineyard is a single estate vineyard located just north of Saint Helena, California at the base of Howell Mountain and planted with 100% Cabernet Sauvignon. The soils are a chocolatey clay, holding moisture to keep the vines cool. As summer progresses, the ground forms micro-cracks, allowing the roots to seek water deeper and deeper into the earth; as they do, they pick up minerals that give Kayli Morgan its distinctive characteristics.

Few & Far Between Vineyard

Few and Far Between is one of three estate vineyards, all of which are farmed organically although they are not certified. The 5-acre Few and Far Between is tucked deep in a small valley in Calistoga. Just down a gentle slope is historic Eisele Vineyard, best known as the source of Araujo Estate's Cabernet Sauvignon and considered hallowed ground by many. The pristine site, planted in rocky alluvial soils, is 90% Cabernet Sauvignon and the rest Cabernet Franc.

Wraith

Wraith is a trinity of Hundred Acre's three single vineyard wines. It is a selection of barrels set aside in the cellar from those waiting to be blended someday into the single vineyard wines from Kayli Morgan, ARK or Few and Far Between. All very different and incredibly unique. The Wraith shows all the beauty and personality of each individual vineyard and how they come together to develop even greater complexity.

JOSEPH PHELPS VINEYARDS

Joseph Phelps Vineyards is a family-owned and operated wine estate with vineyards and wineries in Napa Valley and on the western Sonoma Coast. The winery was founded in 1973 by Joseph Phelps, a successful construction executive and entrepreneur whose early interest in wine led him to establish vineyards on a 670-acre former cattle ranch in Napa Valley.

Over the next 42 years Joe became one of the most respected figures in the California wine industry, building Joseph Phelps Vineyards into a critically-acclaimed winery internationally known for its iconic wines and unwavering commitment to quality.



BEAULIEU VINEYARD

In 1938, Georges de Latour travelled to France's Pasteur Institute to recruit a winemaker and viticulturist to bring his expertise to Rutherford in Napa Valley. Andre Tchelistcheff, a Russian émigré joined Beaulieu Vineyard, his experience, insights and leadership revolutionized not only Beaulieu Vineyard but the entire Napa Valley wine industry. His pursuit of higher wine quality and continuous innovation earned him the industry's most famous title 'The Maestro'.

Overture reflects the winemaker's artistry by showcasing the talent of blending five traditional Bordeaux grape varieties and capturing terroir characteristics of the same variety grown in different soils. However, Overture's third blending aspect – that of marrying multiple vintages – yields a softer, rounder expression of our estate that can be enjoyed upon release.
