Re-Creating your Basic T-Shirt Class

We all have a favorite basic t-shirt that we love to wear, but it needs replacing. This class involves taking your basic t-shirt and creating a pattern from it, followed by sewing it up with your serger. A good understanding of seam allowances, as well as using your serger is an important requirement for this class. We will be using a cover hem to put the finishing touches on your t-shirt.

Skill Level: Intermediate

Supplies needed:

Your favorite basic T-Shirt

Clear plastic tablecloth (from Dollarama or Dollar tree)

Black sharpie marker fine tip

1 – 1.5 meters (depending on sleeve length) pre-washed cotton jersey fabric (95% cotton, 5% spandex preferred for best results)

4 spools serger thread matching your fabric as best as possible.

**Additional 2 spools of exact matching sewing thread for the cover hem if your serger thread is not exact match.

Pins and a hand-sewing needle

Fabric marker

Scissors

Measuring tape

Ruler

Serger in good working condition, with manual and accessories
