




# **SPECTREDIVER**

Owner's Manual

# SETTING TIME ON WATCH



## 1 Winding position (Crown in position)

Rotate clockwise to wind the watch. Give the watch 30 winds to get it around 30 hours of power reserve. DO NOT OVERWIND the watch.

## 2 Time position

Pull the crown at the first click position and rotate the crown counter-clockwise to set the time.

### SECURING THE CROWN

Push the crown back in after setting the time. There should be a light click to ensure the crown seal is secure.

### IMPORTANT NOTE

Do not over-wind the movement. Do not continue winding after you feel resistance during manual winding process. Broken spring from over winding/ misuse is not covered by the warranty.

### POLISHING YOUR PLEXIGLASS

Any light scratches on the plexiglass crystal on the watch can be easily polished with some PolyWatch that you can buy online easily.

### SIZING YOUR BRACELET

We recommend using low-strength thread-locker such as Loctite 222 on the screws for a secure fit for the bracelet after sizing.

# GENERAL CARE INSTRUCTIONS

- ❖ Ensure that the crown is fully pushed in before submerging in water.
- ❖ Do not attempt to open the caseback of the watch without professional help or prior approval from HVD Watches.
- ❖ Rinse the watch in fresh water after submerging in salt water.
- ❖ Do not use soap to wash the canvas watch strap and air-dry the strap after cleaning

## Frequently asked questions

### 1. **My watch is not moving when I receive it. What can I do?**

The SpectreDiver comes with a handwound mechanical movement. You will need to wind the watch using the crown to get the watch moving.

### 2. **My watch is not keeping the power reserve of up to 42hrs, is there something wrong?**

Like a brand new car, you need to run in your brand new watch movement for a few days before it start to perform to factory standard. Wear/wind your watch regularly to ensure its always moving.

### 3. **My watch is not keeping time accurately, what can I do?**

Your watch may be magnetized. A watchmaker with a demagnetizer will be able to fix the issue within minutes, for a minimal fee.

### 4. **Can I polish my watch?**

Yes, it can be done so professionally by watch maker or simply by use a piece of Cape Cod cloth. The scratches on the plexiglass can also be easily polished of with some PolyWatch.
