Setting Instructions

HOW TO SET UP THE TRAP



1. Open Mustelid Trap lid.



2. Place foot on base of housing, lift trap kill bar to set position over Waddington trigger. The Waddington trigger will fall towards the treadle plate.



3. Carefully lower the kill bar to engage the top edge of the Waddington trigger.



4. Make sure the bottom of the Waddington trigger is resting on the front face of the pierced tab on the treadle plate.

The trap is now set!

TO REMOVE THE DEAD PEST



5. Lift kill bar and secure safety clip as shown and proceed to remove dead pest.



6. Once clean, remove safety clip while maintaining hand pressure on the kill bar. For re-setting follow steps 2 - 4.



7. To secure trap housing use screw provided.



When using the Doc Setting Tool place tool to the right hand side of the Waddington trigger. For re-setting follow steps 2 - 4.

DOC SETTING TOOL
